# Lonny Wade Memorial Scholarship

We have put together 2 scholarships in the amount of \$2,000.00 each in the name of Lonny Wade! Lonny was a very generous man that was always willing to help anyone in the time of need. He was a certified Health and Safety Trainer that worked with many businesses to promote safety in the workplace. Lonny passed away in January of 2021 of pancreatic cancer. He had many passions including hunting and fishing and grew up in Vermont. He came from a background in law enforcement and promoted the trades to all young people that he came in contact with. We feel confident that he would be pleased to know that he was helping someone even after his death.

This scholarship is open to all students entering a trade but not necessarily enrolled in a tech program.

**Criteria:**

Trades eligible for scholarship: Plumbing, heating, Electrician, Building, concrete, roofing, surveying, carpentry, welding, heavy equipment, HVAC, engineering, forestry and natural resources, law enforcement, public safety, emergency services, fire services and automotive.

**Student eligibility:** Student must maintain a proficient grade with a recommendation letter from their teacher. Also, a letter from the student stating their course of study and a brief explanation about themselves and their future intentions and a copy of their acceptance letter.

If chosen, student will receive a check for the first half of the scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 made payable to their school. The second half in the amount of \$1,000.00, made payable to them upon receiving proof of passing grades at the beginning of the second semester.
