2024 Chenault Scholarship Requirements

A completed Richmond Exchange Club Scholarship application packet includes:

1. The completed application form, signed by a school guidance counselor and the applicant
2. A 500-750 word essay that describes your vision of how your continuing education will serve to promote the National Exchange Club mission to inspire communities to become better places to live through service, family, community and country
3. All high school transcripts with non-weighted GPA and any standardized test scores
4. A resume' listing and describing the extracurricular activities you have participated in during your high school years. These include not only school extracurriculars but endeavors such as volunteer work, church activities, and employment, as well as participation in team or club sports, membership in organizations such as Future Farmers of America, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, etc. Be careful to list any instances where you took a leadership role.

Please note: Applicant must be a graduating senior from a Madison County high school with plans to continue their education in a college or university, trade school, or apprenticeship environment. An incomplete or unreadable application will not be considered.
