PESTICIDE NOTIFICATION

This letter, in compliance with RCW 17.21.415, and in conjunction with School Policy 6895, is intended to keep our parents, staff, and community informed of pest control policies, methods, and requirements of Pesticide applications/usage in our landscape and athletic field areas.

Per State requirement, a minimum of 48-hrs prior to any non-emergency pesticide application, a sign will be posted in each office of the School where the application is made. The posting will include the following details:

1. Name of pesticide, date and time of application.
2. Pest (vegetation or insect) to be controlled.
3. Location of the pesticide application.
4. Name and telephone number of contact person for the School District.

The School District has a 48-hour window from the intended date within which to apply the product, and to allow for weather conditions which sometimes affect the ability to apply.

Postings of emergency applications will be placed in the School Office and at the location of the application immediately following application.

At the time of application and for a minimum of 24-hrs, a poster or flag will be placed at the primary entrance(s) of the application area. This flag, for landscape application, will state that the area has been recently sprayed or treated and will include the name of the person to call for more information.

The Chimacum School District uses pesticide landscape applications by hand-held sprayers, small boom sprayers, and back-pack sprayers.

All precautions are taken to ensure students and staff are not present during or immediately after applications.
