Thank you for submitting your revised COVID-19 Safety Plan (CSP) to reopen your middle schools for in-person instruction to 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. Our panel has completed a review of the plan and is in agreement that Folsom Cordova Unified School District can proceed with reopening middle school in-person instruction to **6<sup>th</sup> grade students only** with the following minor changes to your plan:

- COVID-19 School Guidance Checklist must be updated to indicate that only 6<sup>th</sup> grade is reopening at this time. Grades 7-12 may not reopen for in-person instruction until Sacramento County has moved to the Red Tier on the California Blueprint for a Safer Economy.
- Plan should explicitly state that students must remain in Track A or Track B and that they will not move between tracks.
