- b. Science Wing Garden thank you to Steve Flagg for helping getting the two new trees planted at no cost to HSC; will continue to work on the garden, but trying to save some money so this may push into next school year
- c. Goodwill Drive Fundraiser (4/27) have been advertising early (in the Panther Paw) and have confirmed that there are no other Goodwill fundraisers planned anytime near ours so hoping for a good turnout; will have a sign-up genius to solicit student help (to earn volunteer hours)
- d. SJ Giants Baseball Fundraiser (5/4 at 5pm)— advertising has begun; we have a flyer and a QR code to send in an email; our "revenue" is tier-based (the more we sell, the more we get)
 - i. Tickets will be \$18 per ticket plus \$3 service fee. We have 100 tickets for sale. If we sold all 100, Price earns back \$540.
- e. 8th Grade Yard Signs want to minimize waste and make sure parents that want them, get them since there were so many leftover last year (ordered 250 for \$1758 and probably had at least half left); maybe order 150 and offer it first come, first serve (Sarah to reach out to Custom Yard Signs and find out how much it will cost for 150 vs 250 last year; what is lead time, etc).

5. Treasurers Update - Raul Silva

- a. Approx. \$93,500 in the bank as of today, not including a \$10K matching check from CEF received last week but not deposited yet (Erika will be doing that today)
- b. We received checks from Starbird and from World Wraps FNO totaling \$341; and we received \$60.60 from Box Tops (passive fundraising)
- c. Erika is still working on updating Giving Campaign levels and where we're at
- d. Teachers need get their reimbursements in

6. Committee Updates

- a. Family Night Out Aletta Godden
 - i. Wednesday March 13 Chipotle (5 9pm Camden location only) Price earns back 33% as long we reach \$150 in sales; in person or online (direct on their website, not thru a 3rd party); there is a code to use on the flyer for the FNO
- b. Hospitality Michelle Garcia
 - i. 2 weeks ago, we had snacks, drinks and coffees for the teachers
 - ii. The next one is in April (after spring break) and it will be a lunch for the teachers
- c. Starting Arts (Newsies play 4/18-4/19, 5 & & 7:30 showtimes, with no intermission)— Kendy Lundgaard
 - i. Show prep/practice is going great with about 50 kids involved:
 - ii. Trying to determine if we should sell concessions (maybe before the show, since they're considering not having an intermission, and need to consider how much of a mess will it make (to minimize the time the custodian spends since they need to be out by 10pm))
 - iii. How much to charge for tickets given that Videographer will cost \$700 and Tshirts will cost \$750; maybe \$10/each and market not only to middle school families, but to other elementary schools too (likely will sell 500+ tickets, so it will more than cover expenses)

d. FunFest – Michelle Garcia

- i. Logo design contest received about 7 or 8 in total and just chose one to send to the printers for a mockup; Tshirt sales are delayed because of issues with the HSC webstore, but sounds like it's being/been resolved so sales can start this week and go thru beginning of April and then be sent to be made; ticket sales will start beginning of April
- ii. Nobody showed up last night for the planning meeting on the zoom (29); maybe issues with the link/password, so maybe should try doing an in-person meeting? Or include instructions on the sign-up genius for those parents who've signed up to help during the Fun Fest as to what they're going to be doing and expectations
