Scarborough Schools Community,

On Monday April 8, 2024, All Scarborough Schools will be dismissing students one hour earlier than usual: grades K-5 at

2:15pm, and 6-12 at 1:25pm. This is in response to a once in a lifetime solar eclipse event that will be at its peak during the normally scheduled dismissal time. Our goal in making this adjustment is to keep all of our students, staff, and families safe, minimize disruption for that day, and provide an opportunity for our kids to experience and learn from this unique astronomical phenomenon.

We appreciate your patience and understanding and do not anticipate changes to extracurricular or after-school activities planned for that day. Many of our teachers are already finding innovative ways to capitalize on this special event as a unique learning opportunity for our kids!

School Building Advisory Committee (SBAC)

NEW CITIZEN-LED SCHOOL BUILDING ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO ASSIST IN DEVELOPING SCHOOL SOLUTION

Scarborough's **School Building Advisory Committee** (SBAC) was created to bring the public into the school planning process at the ground level. The SBAC was formed after the Unified School Proposal was rejected by the voters in Nov 2023. Following the referendum's defeat, the Town Council and School Board sought to bring the public back into the conversation about a school solution. SBAC members include volunteers from the Scarborough community who bring expertise and interests to the table, as well as select elected officials.

SBAC members have divided into subcommittees focusing on different aspects of school needs. Their work now is to review and analyze the materials of the previous School building committee as they seek a fiscally responsible solution for Scarborough's school deficiencies.

When results from the town-wide survey are available, SBAC members will use this data to inform their analysis and recommendations for a school solution.


FY25 School Budget - Ways to Get Informed

The first reading of the <u>FY25 school budget</u> was approved by the School Board at their March 21, 2024 meeting. At the March 27th Town Council meeting, a joint FY25 budget presentation was given by Town Manager, Tom Hall, and Superintendent, Geoff Bruno. Next steps include a joint Town Council/School Board budget workshop at 5:30 pm on April 3rd at Town Hall, followed by the Town Council's first reading of the overall Scarborough budget for FY25.



The 2nd reading of the FY25 school budget and Board approval is set for May 4th. There are several additional upcoming opportunities for the community to review/comment on the FY25 proposed budget.
