



Chalk Art Day was filled with creativity and fun!

# 2024-2025 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

**Enrollment for the 2024-2025 School Year is underway.** Current students do not need to re-enroll including Waggoner 5th grade students who are going to Kyrene Middle School. If a student is changing schools for the 2024-2025 school year, a Current Student/Change School Request needs to be completed online for the 2024-2025 school year.

Visit <u>Kyrene's Online Registration</u> to enroll your child(ren). Online registration records will be flagged as an Open Enrollment application for students who live outside the school's boundaries. Open Enrollment must be approved before registration is considered final.

**Documents Needed to Complete Registration:** 

Families have the option to upload these documents through the online portal or drop them off in person at the school.

- Certified Birth Certificate
- Immunization Records
- Proof of Residency (e.g. current utility bill, lease agreement, mortgage document)
- Government-issued Photo I.D.
- Individual Student Records (e.g. report cards, test scores, attendance/behavior records, special education records, etc.)


# **SITE COUNCIL 2024-2025**

### Smart Snacks For Sale At Lunch

Kyrene and SFE want to assure you that when your child chooses to enjoy ala carte snacks from their cafeteria, they are selecting options that meet the strict nutritional standards outlined by the USDA's Smart Snack guidelines. These guidelines prioritize offering snacks that are lower in fat, sugar, and sodium, while also providing essential nutrients to support your child's overall health and well-being. The guidelines require that drinks be either unflavored water or 100% juice, and that snacks contain at least 50% whole grain or list the first ingredient as a fruit, vegetable, dairy food, or protein food. It's also important to note that while some snack packaging may appear similar to those found in stores outside of school, each product has been carefully reformulated to comply with federal Smart Snack guidelines. Our foodservice management company, SFE, works diligently to ensure that all snacks offered to students are both delicious and nutritious, meeting or exceeding federal standards.



Under the Arizona tax credit program, tax payers can direct a portion of their state income tax to a specific program such as sports or other extra-curricular activity, or to a school.
