NISD is excited to offer full-day Pre-K for qualifying and tuition-based students at all campuses for the 2024-2025 school year!



State-funded Pre-K is available for qualifying NISD children

To be eligible for the free program, a child must live in Northwest ISD and be four years old by September 1, 2024. The federal government prioritizes Pre-K students by the following criteria:

- Unable to speak and comprehend the English language*
- Educationally disadvantaged (eligible for free or reduced-price lunch program)
- Homeless, as defined by 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 1143A
- Child of an active duty member of the Armed Forces of the United States, or is the child of a member of the Armed Forces of the United States who was injured or killed while serving on active duty
- Be in, or have been in, the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services
- Child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas award
