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This plan is developed through partnerships with Greenleaf Family Center Mental Health Counseling, PSI School Health Services, and Summit Co Educational Service Center.

**\*\*New this year, at least 50% of the Student Wellness funds must be spent on mental and/or physical health services.\*\***

### Student Wellness Funds Will Be Spent On:

- A Part Time School Counselor at Nolley (Mental Health Services)
- PSI School Nursing Services (Physical Health Services)
- Greenleaf Mental Health Counseling (Mental Health Services)
- School Resource Officer Contract (Prevention Services)
- Replacement AED's throughout the district (Physical Health Services)
- Replacement Infant Simulators (Culturally Appropriate Prevention Services)

In FY 25, the use of funds will remain the same with the contract of a full -time counselor at Nolley and contracting with the Summit Co Education Service Center for a Family Support Liaison.

### Disadvantaged Pupil Impact Funds Will Be Spent On:

- School Resources Officer Contract (School Safety)
- An additional staff member to support students in intervention and reading supports (Reading Improvement and Intervention)
