Compassionate health care for St. Louis Park youth - infancy through high school

- 2023-2024 School Year - Open through June 6th
- 2024-2025 School Year – Opening August 6th
- Closed over summer

Services are no cost and include:

- Treatment for acute illness and injuries
- Well-child/baby check ups
- Immunizations/vaccines* (**for uninsured/Medical Assistance/MNCARE**)
- Sports & camp physicals
- Sexual health care
- Interpreters can be arranged by calling ahead of time

*at this time, we are not able to give COVID vaccines.

Walk-In:

- Patients are seen in order of arrival.

Consent:

- Written consent by a parent or guardian required annually. (By Minnesota law, students can give permission for their sexual health services.)
