
Number Animals

You will need: Paper Pencil Crayons/Markers/Colored Pencils

Art & Math Connection

The elements of art are to art what the ABCs are to reading. This project uses the elements of LINE and FORM as well as the principle of SHAPE.

In this project, you will learn how to turn numbers into animals just by adding in a few more lines.




To Make A Kangaroo:

- 1. Start by drawing the number 5.
- 2. Beginning from the BOTTOM, draw a CURVED LINE to make a half circle.
- 3. End it with a straight line to make the Kangaroo's pouch.
- 4. Draw a slanted line next to the vertical line on the 5.
- 5. Add a curved line to close the top of the shape.
- 6. Draw a curved line to make a muzzle, then add feet, arms, ears and a tail.
- 7. When your picture is finished, color it in and add a background!

To Make A Rat

- 1. Draw a 2.
- Beginning at the top of the two, draw a CURVED LINE up and around for the head, continuing down to a slant line out for the head.
- 3. Close the shape with a SLANT LINE in.
- 4. Add a curved line for a leg, and small circles for ears and a foot.
- 5. Using the bottom of the 2, make a tail.
- 6. Add a small circle for a nose.
- 7. Draw whiskers on the end of the nose.
- 8. Draw arms and hands just above the small half circle you made for the leg.
- 9. Add another line for the second leg and foot.
- 10. Draw an eye.
- 11. You are now ready to add in details for your Rat and color it in!
