

# Daily Elementary Art Lesson

## Day 5

# 3D Hand Drawing

The elements of art are to art what the ABCs are to reading. This project uses the elements of LINE and FORM.

**Art & Science Connection OPTICAL ILLUSIONS** can use color, light and patterns to create images that can be deceptive or misleading to our brains. The information gathered by the eye is processed by the brain, creating a perception that does not match the true image.

**OPTICAL ILLUSION ART**, or **OP Art** for short, intentionally exploits that oddity of human perception that gives the human eye the ability to deceive the human brain.

In this project, you will create an optical illusion—a 2D image that looks 3D!

#### Step 1.

Place your hand on your paper and trace it lightly, using a pencil.

#### Step 2.

Using your pen or marker, draw a straight line until you get to your pencil line. When you get to your pencil line, draw a curved line from one pencil line to the other. When you get to the other side, continue to draw a straight line. (If that 's tricky, here 's a tip: draw the curved lines first, then go back and connect them with straight lines.)

## Step 3.


Repeat until you have covered the whole page in lines.

## Step 4. (Optional)

Add color to your picture to make it pop.
