Day 24

Craft Stick Puzzle

This project uses the art elements of **COLOR** and **LINE**.

COLOR is made up of three properties: hue, value, and intensity.

- **HUE** name of color
- **VALUE** hue's lightness and darkness (a color's value changes when white or black is added)
- **INTENSITY** quality of brightness and purity
 - **HIGH INTENSITY** color is **strong and bright**
 - **LOW INTENSITY** color is **faint and dull**

You will need:
Popsicle sticks
Colored Markers
Paper Strips & Scissors
(Optional)

Step 1.

Line up your popsicle sticks so that all the ends are even (you may tape them together on one side to help keep them stable while you work).

**If you are using PAPER: select the paper size you would like.

Step 2.

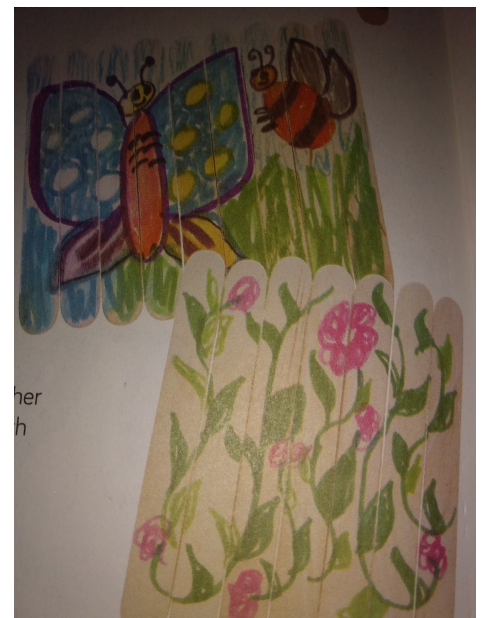
Draw a picture/scene on the opposite side of your popsicle sticks (the side that **DOES NOT** have tape, if you taped it) or on your paper. (Here's an idea: draw some of the Zentangles from yesterday's lesson!)

Step 3.

Remove the tape from the popsicle sticks.

**If you are using PAPER: cut your picture into strips or shapes.

YOU NOW HAVE A PUZZLE!



Ask someone in your house to solve your puzzle (you may have to help them if they can't figure it out!).

Maybe next time they can make a puzzle for you to solve!
