Kool-Aid Playdough

We're going to have some fun today!

This week we have been learning about **form**, one of the elements of art. Form is something three dimensional, or with the appearance of being three dimensional. Today you will be making dough that you can then form into 3D sculptures.

You will need: Flour Salt Kool-Aid Vegetable oil Boiling water Mixing bowl & spoon

Did you know you can make your own Playdough out of Kool-Aid? Which means you can make it your favorite color or flavor! (But that doesn't mean you can eat it. Please DON'T eat it!)
