

SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS

Recipient: The winning student will be awarded a \$2,000.00 scholarship

Eligibility: The applicant must be a child, stepchild; grandchild, step grandchild; or great grandchild, step great grandchild of a Vietnam/Vietnam Era Veteran.

The applicant must provide proof of acceptance and registration from an accredited educational, technical college or university as a minimum of a half time student.

Essay:

The student who is applying for the scholarship must write an essay in their own words.

Title- "Should the United States have gone to war in South Vietnam?"

Description: Why did the United States decide to go to war in South Vietnam? What was the benefit to the United States of supporting the South Vietnamese government? What were the practical and political costs of the United States support of the South Vietnamese government? What lessons were learned?

Essay Requirements: 475 minimum-500-word maximum, font 12, double spaced.

Application:

Provide: Full Name, Address, Phone Number, Name of High School and District, Your relationship to the Vietnam/Vietnam Era Veteran.

Also include: Copy of your high school transcripts and your letter of acceptance from the college/university.

Copy of letter or document providing proof of registration to the accepted college or university.
Copy of parent's or grandparent's DD214 or Discharge Document.

Deadline: The completed application form and required information must be **postmarked** no later than **June 15, 2024**
