### Opening

District Advisory Committee Chair Angela Kopnicky called the meeting to order. School Board Member Mr. Carl Persis; Dr. Carmen Balgobin, Superintendent; Mr. Todd Seis, Chief Financial Officer; Dr. Angel Teron, REA Coordinator; and Danielle Johnson, Communications Director, were all in attendance.

Ms. Kopnicky welcomed DAC members and congratulated Mainland High's football team on their state championship. Ms. Marinaccio, shared with committee members District Advisory Committee name will officially become the District Advisory Council after the official vote takes place at the March 6 meeting. The minutes from the December 6, 2023, DAC meeting were unanimously approved.

- District overall went from 57% to 61% only 1% from becoming an A district
- 54 schools in the district received an A or B grade
- This is the first time since 2008 that no D or F grades were received
