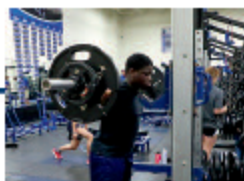

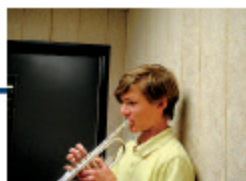

The boys soccer team made it to the second round of the state playoffs. The football team made it to semi-final round of state playoffs. The boys cross country team placed sixth at the state meet. The girls cross country team placed fourth at the state meet. The varsity girls volleyball team placed fourth at the state tournament. The girls tennis team placed second in the state tournament. The cheer team placed second at the state competition. The dance team placed third at the state competition. The boys golf team placed fourth at the state meet. Bergen Reilly received the South Dakota Miss Volleyball for the AA class. She also received the Volleyball Gatorade Player of the year for the third year in a row!

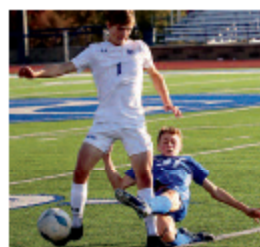

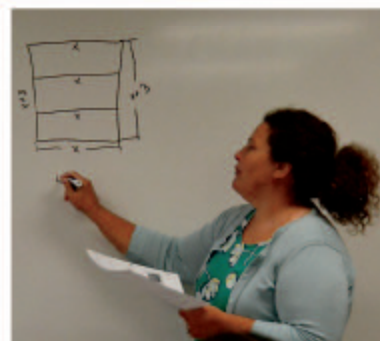
Another great year of instruction, activities, events and athletics was provided by O'Gorman High School administration and staff.
