# BACK

# Academic division division Blue

O'Gorman High School was named a 2021 National Blue Ribbon School for the fourth time. Previous wins include 1985, 2005 and 2014. This honor is given to only 50 schools per year and as of 2021, only 10 high schools (public or private) had been honored with this award four times.

In order to be considered for this award, ACT scores must be in the top 15% in the nation. O'Gorman's average composite is 26.4. The application process also requires schools to demonstrate excellence in areas including climate and culture, curriculum and instruction, academic support, leadership, extra-curricular activities, and more. "Every single O'Gorman student and staff played a role in us winning this award. I have never been more proud to be an O'Gorman Knight!" said Principal Joan Mahoney.

This year six new faces joined the staff: Ms. Soukup teaching Spanish, Ms. Myers teaching English, Mr. Zwach teaching College Computer Science, Mr. Engbers directing choir and Ovation!, Mr. Lehn in counseling and Ms. VandenBos in the front office.

The Theology department also welcomed the Pro Ecclesia Sancta religious order. The clergy, brought in by Bishop Donald DeGrood, consists of Sr. Eileen, Sr. Lynn, Br. Brian, Br. Johannes, Br. Kevin, Br. David and Fr. Juan Carlos.





# Athletica

The O'Gorman Knights had an exciting fall season full of state appearances and titles. The girl's cross country team placed first at state for the second year in a row, with senior Alea Hardie claiming the individual state title for the third time. Hardie was also named the Cross Country Girls Gatorade Player of the Year. The boy's golf team claimed the first place title over the Lincoln Patriots in a two-hole playoff with junior Radley Mauney sinking a ten-foot putt to birdie on the last hole. Boys soccer returned to the state championship facing off against Yankton, taking home the first runner-up trophy. Volleyball, with back-to-back championship wins, beat Washington in the final round after being down two sets to zero. They came back to win three straight sets. Junior Bergen Reilly participated in the U-18 World Volleyball Championship with Team USA where she brought home a bronze medal. Reilly was also named the Gatorade Player of the Year for the second year in a row. Competitive cheer was in a constant battle with Harrisburg and Jefferson throughout the season. They triumphantly came out on top to bring home yet another state title for O'Gorman.

During the winter season activities, the gymnastics team brought home their first state title since 2005. Junior Maeve Boetel broke the All-Around school record four times during the season, twice at state within 24 hours. Junior Audrey Meyer tied the school floor record. Wrestling had its inaugural year for a female team. Girls basketball added to the state championship wall with a win over Rapid City Stevens in the Championship. They ended their season with a 21-3 record. Boys finished as first runner up after falling to the undefeated Roosevelt Rough Riders. In the semi-final round, the Knights beat the Washington Warriors in an overtime, buzzer-beater basket.

A rainy and chilly start to the spring season postponed multiple golf invites, tennis matches and track meets. Midway through April, the weather began to warm up and the students took to the fields once again. Boys tennis took 3rd at state by claiming third in almost every event except for Will Koziara's singles win. The girl's track and field team claimed the first place title for the second year in a row with numerous of the senior girls taking first in individual titles. Senior Alea Hardie broke the AA Girls 800 meter run state record. Seniors Megan VanDenHemel won the shot put with Avery Wittry taking second and winning the discus. Wittry was named the field MVP and Alea Hardie was named the track MVP. Junior Audrey Meyer claimed the 100 meter hurdles gold. Girls golf placed 6th with senior Lauren Sutcliffe taking home the individual silver.



Four days and three attempts later, the Bob Burn's 43rd Dakota Bowl came to a close on Tuesday, August 31. Students, staff and fans returned to McEneaney Field for the second year in a row. Initially set to be played on Saturday, August 28, a flash flood warning, a thunderstorm watch and a tornado warning delayed the game. Players were warming up on the field and fans were trickling into the stadium when an announcement to evacuate due to lightning came from the speakers. Almost instantly, the sky opened up in a downpour sending everyone running for cover. Students and fans took refuge within the walls of the high school while eagerly waiting to hear the verdict from coaching staff Saturday night. Word was back-and-forth about playing later that evening. Around 9 p.m., the decision was made to play at 4 p.m. on Monday, August 30. Students were disappointed, but they kept the spirit alive. On Monday, fans swarmed to the stadium. This time the game started. The Knights were the first to score in the first quarter, but Roosevelt came back with a touchdown in the second quarter with a failed two point conversion. At half time, the Marching Band prepared to take the field when yet another lightning delay was declared with immediate evacuation into the school. The score sat at 7-6 in favor of the Knights. By 8 p.m., the game once again was rescheduled this time to Tuesday, August 31 at 4 p.m. Students and fans once again packed into the stadium Tuesday afternoon. The game started at the beginning of the second half. Emanuel Struck scored for the Knights in the third quarter with a 75-yd touchdown. Andrew Nelson completed a field goal to set the score to 14-6, Knights. With only a few minutes remaining in the fourth quarter, Roosevelt inched into the end zone to score a touchdown, but once again failed on the two point conversion leaving the score at 14-12. The clock ticked down with the ball in the Knight's possession. The final score remained at 14-12, Knights, Following the game, students rushed the field to pray with the team, a beloved tradition O'Gorman students haven't been able to participate in since 2019.


























# G L A S S
