Despite the many hardships, this has been the year for state titles. The boys soccer team won their first state title in school history. Girls volleyball not only won state with an undefeated season, but at week 9 they were ranked 11th out of the top 25 teams in the nation. Sophomore Bergen Reilly was named Gatorade Volleyball Player of the Year and Midco Volleyball Player of the Year. The girls cross-country team won with junior Alea Hardie taking 1st for the second consecutive year. Senior Katherine Castelli was awarded Gatorade player of the year for distance running. Junior William Sanford won the state title for boys golf. The Knights had a very exciting fall season. For the winter season, the girls basketball team took third place and the boys team took second place. Senior Isabelle Moore received the Spirit of Su award. Gymnastics took sixth place at state.

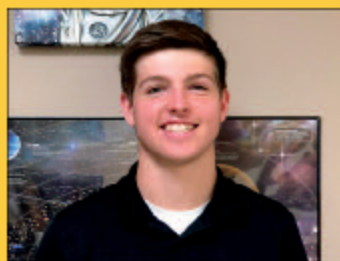

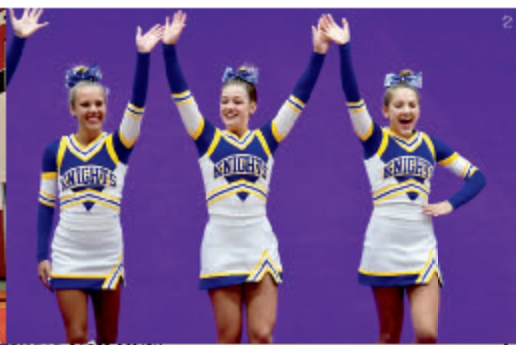

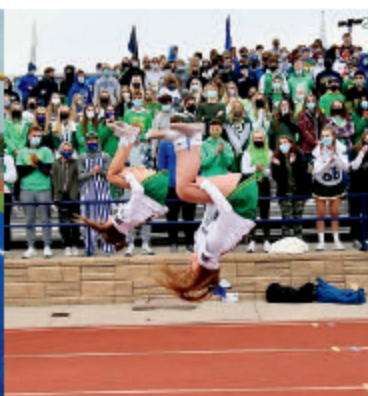
HOMEcoming

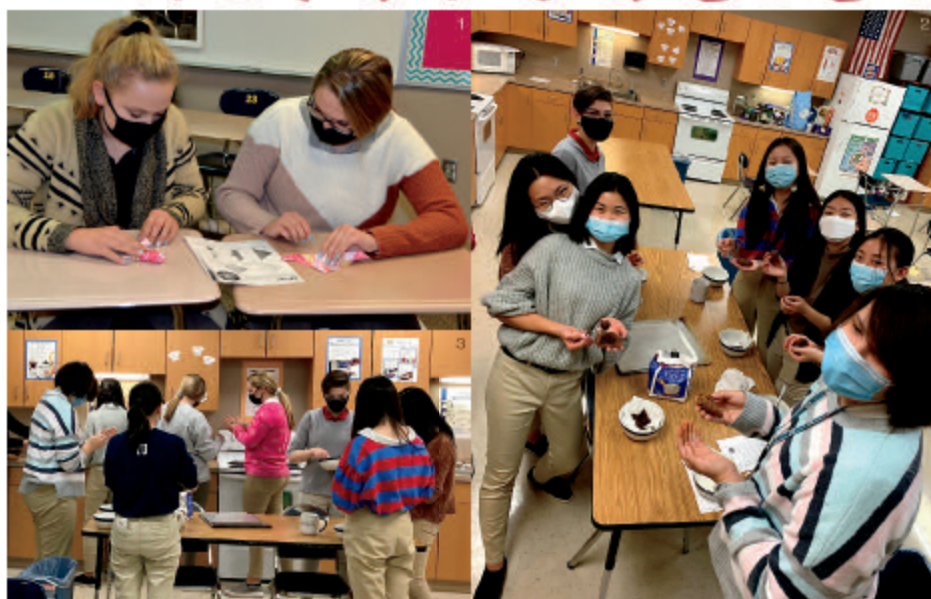

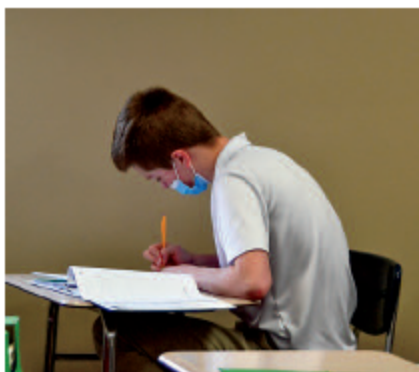

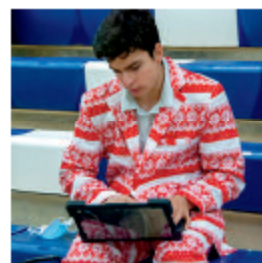


Class of 2023
