## OUR IMPRESSIVE GROWTH

Over the last 5 years MC's enrollment growth in both its Boys and Girls Division has increased the need for additional academic and athletic facilities. Due to the limits of available classroom spaces MC has been forced to purchase temporary portable classrooms to educate all of its students.

The enrollment growth has also made it difficult for many of our teams to maintain a full practice schedule due to limited field times. Due to the overwhelming success of the codivisional model and MC being the only affordable high-quality Catholic school option in the area, we do not see the demand for seats declining.






### 50 CRYSTAL STREET

#### **BUILD OUT A 7th &8th GRADE MODEL**


- This plan includes the construction of 12 new classrooms and lab spaces, a dining hall, and office space.
- It addresses the demand from current families for an MC education starting in 7th grade.
- It allows MC to offer an academically rigorous, codivisional model spanning grades 7-12.


### SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVE ATHLETIC FACILITIES

- The project includes a new 30,000-square-foot indoor turf field, a 6,000-square-foot basketball court, and a state-of-the-art wellness center with a weight room.
- It will enable MC to meet the athletic demands of all students, including 27 different varsity sports teams and intramural offerings.
- It ensures MC can provide high-end facilities to remain competitive with other in-demand schools.

#### ADVANCED ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

- Plans involve the creation of four new classrooms dedicated to MC's increasingly differentiated curriculum.
- There will be space for entrepreneurial studies, biomedical science research, and full-year laboratory research.
- This expansion allows MC to enhance and strengthen program offerings for students, meeting the needs of today's learners and tomorrow's professional careers.

## CODIVISIONAL 7-12 SCHOOL

#### The Time for a Middle School is Now.

Over the past five years, MC's enrollment has increased by nearly 80% due to the strong success and popularity of our codivisional model. This increasing demand is expected to continue. In a recent survey, MC's parents strongly supported the expansion of the MC experience to include 7th and 8th graders.

- MC's Boys and Girls Divisions are unique as the only single-sex academic high school experiences in Massachusetts without an affiliated middle school.
- Current parents are eager for an MC option starting in 7th grade.
- Students in 7th and 8th grade have become increasingly specialized, especially in STEM courses, necessitating differentiated and advanced programming. This shift compels academically-focused families to choose high schools with integrated middle schools, ensuring their children remain on the highest academic track.
- MC's student body from public schools has almost tripled in just six years, sparking greater interest from public school families seeking an MC option earlier for their children.
- Given Malden Catholic's demand nearing maximum capacity, we anticipate significant interest in a 7th and 8th grade option.
- The 50 Crystal Street development will accommodate a middle school of approximately 200 students, equipped with classrooms, a dining hall, gymnasium, and specialized facilities.

### ADVANCED ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

The new facilities will play a pivotal role in expanding our differentiated programming for students. The dedicated classrooms for **Entrepreneurship** and **Financial Literacy** will catalyze the growth of our Business program, enabling MC to host entrepreneurship venture competitions, invite business speakers, and foster a competitive DECA competition team.

The newly established **Biomedical Engineering** lab will facilitate the addition of more biomedical classes within the school's Project Lead the Way Program. These programs will, in turn, reinforce our existing internship program, enabling over 200 MC students annually to engage in STEM research with college professors, pursue business internships with MC alumni, and participate in community-based internships in the Arts and Environmental Sciences. We firmly believe that these new facilities will propel MC into the future.

There is an increasing demand among our students for programs dedicated to addressing real-world problems and preparing for the jobs of the future. MC already has hundreds of students enrolled in these programs, and these new classrooms will significantly strengthen and enrich our differentiated offerings.







### **SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORT**

Malden Catholic has a long history of supporting families within our communities. In the past year, Malden Catholic provided Needs-Based Scholarships to over 80% of its students. This scholarship support plays a critical role in maintaining a diverse student body characterized by hard work, high motivation, and unwavering determination to succeed. These students proudly represent our local communities of Malden, Medford, Everett, Revere, Melrose, and the cities and towns North of Boston.

- MC annually distributes almost \$5 million in Needs-Based scholarship support to families.
- MC serves its communities with a 40% diversity rate, with nearly half of our families originating from the gateway communities North of Boston.
- MC aims to substantially increase its reserves for scholarship support through planned gifts, family scholarship funds, and general scholarship support.

### ENHANCED ATHLETIC FACILITIES

To ensure that Malden Catholic continues to thrive for the next 90 years, significant improvements and enhancements of its athletic facilities are needed. Given the increased enrollment and expansion of athletic teams over the last five years, the current facilities no longer adequately support the needs of the growing student body.

- The improved fields will support MC's athletic teams by facilitating to recruitment and retention of top-quality coaches and athletes.
- The upgraded facilities will enhance MC's intramural sports offerings and strengthen community relationships.
- These facilities will enable MC to further distinguish itself and align with our goal of long-term sustainability.
