We will have two different sessions for the Associate Degree Information Night on **Monday, April** 15th:

5:00 - 5:45 p.m. - English Session 6:00 - 6:45 p.m. - Spanish Session

During the Associate Degree Information Night, families will learn about the requirements and options for associate degree completion via Front Range Community College (FRCC) through BVSD college courses taken at their own high school or via online courses. We will also walk families through an <u>example associate degree pathway</u>.

The associate degree and the corresponding course credits from FRCC are accepted at most instate public universities, colleges and institutions and can be applied toward a bachelor's degree. All students are capable of taking these courses and successfully earning college credit while in high school!
