Scholarship Application Guidelines

The application is **due April 26, 2024**. Please return applications via email to tolarmsfa@gmail.com, or return to the school counselor. Applications will not be accepted after April 26, 2024. Scholarship interviews will be conducted on the evening of May 6, 2024, at the Tolar High School library. You will be contacted with the time of your interview time via email. If you are a college student that is unable to interview in person, interviews via conference call or zoom will be available.

The following are guidelines in which scholarship applicants must abide by to apply for the scholarship. To be eligible to apply for the scholarship a high school applicant must have a 2.25 GPA to apply, and a college applicant must have a 2.5 collegiate GPA to apply. Any Tolar High School graduate, whether a former recipient or not, may be considered in subsequent years for scholarship aid by making an application on or before the application deadline each year if eligibility and scholarship guidelines are met. All applications will be screened for eligibility by the Chairman and Secretary/Treasurer. All applicants that are eligible will receive an interview.

If selected as a scholarship recipient, the student must abide by the following guidelines to receive the full scholarship amount. The recipient must have a 2.5 collegiate GPA, must be a full-time student, taking a minimum of 12 semester hours, as well as be in good standing with the institution. The 12-hour semester minimum requirement will be waived for college seniors engaged in student teaching provide the student provides the board with a letter from their advisor confirming the student teaching status. Recipients who are already in college must have a 2.5 GPA standing to apply. College students applying that are unable to provide their GPA at the interview process and who are selected are contingent on GPA, academic standing, and semester hours. In this case, the student will send their final GPA and semester hours to the Foundation Secretary/Treasurer before receiving the scholarship.

The scholarship award will be guaranteed for the first semester only, seeing that the student is enrolled in at least 12 hours and has the minimum GPA requirement. Students must submit their GPA and upcoming class schedule to the Foundation Secretary/Chairman for review following each academic semester to show eligibility before their scholarship disbursement is sent to the institution. Following the Fall semester, the student must have completed 12 semester hours with a 2.5 overall GPA. If semester hours, overall GPA, and good standing are not met, the final scholarship payment will not be sent to the institution. The Chairman will notify the recipient if final scholarship payment is not paid due to ineligibility. All scholarship money awarded must be used within a 12-month period from the date of the award. Students who postpone college or use only a part of their funding may reapply for a new scholarship during the next application period.
