

MEAL PROGRAM: ALLERGY GUIDELINES

Granada Hills Charter provides allergen free meals to all students with a disability or medical condition that limits a major life activity such as breathing or learning; or to students with severe or life-threatening food allergies.

For families needing accommodations, the CNP-925 California Department of Education (CDE) Medical Statement to Request Special Meals and/or Accommodations Form identifies the information required to implement a sound nutrition plan for children with food-related disabilities.
