English Language Learners

Pine Shadows Elementary offers an excellent dual language program for Kindergarten through fifth grade students, with the goal of developing bilingual, biliterate graduates.

Special Education

At Pine Shadows, students with special learning needs are served in Life Skills, Resource and an APPLE (Autism Program Preparing Learners for Excellence) unit as well as in-class support in general education classes. With a focus on fostering independence and vocational readiness, the continuity of special education programs in Spring Branch ISD empowers students with the tools they need to thrive academically and in future pursuits.

Physical Education

Body and mind are connected at Pine Shadows. During regular health fitness activities, teacher coaches deliver action-packed games and drills as well as a health-related curriculum to develop strong students who know how to make healthy choices now and in the years to come.

Fine Arts

The art teacher provides weekly lessons that allow students to creatively express themselves and explore techniques and media to form a foundation for a lifelong appreciation for and participation in art.

All students also attend a weekly music class. Emphasis is placed on active enjoyment of and accomplishments in music-making.

Where possible, collaborative planning by classroom and fine arts teachers results in coordinated lessons that support learning across multiple disciplines.

Gifted & Talented

PSE serves children identified as gifted and talented through the district's elementary screening process. Early grade Gifted & Talented (GT) students participate in the Primary Gifted Program (PGP) on campus. Students in third through fifth grades participate in the district's SPIRAL program.
