

VANDALISM

The North Middlesex Regional School Committee recognizes that vandalism against public and private property is costly and requires positive action through educational programs. Consequently, the Committee will support various programs aimed at reducing the amount of vandalism.

Every citizen of the town, staff members, students, and members of the police department are urged by the North Middlesex Regional School Committee to cooperate in reporting any incidents of vandalism to property under the control of the school department and the name(s) of the person or persons believed to be responsible. Each employee will report to the school principal every incident of vandalism known to them and, if known, the names of those responsible.

The Superintendent is authorized to sign a criminal complaint and to press charges against perpetrators of vandalism against school property and is further authorized to delegate, as they see fit, authority to sign such complaints and to press charges.

Parents and students will be made aware of the legal implications involved. In addition, reimbursement will be sought for all or part of any damages.
