Out of State Students

At its discretion, the North Middlesex Regional School District School Committee may accept students from communities in other states on a tuition basis.

Procedure

- 1. Parents/Guardians will make written application via a letter to the Superintendent of Schools stating reason (s) for request and expected grade assignment of child (ren).
- 2. The child (ren) will then be eligible to participate in the school choice lottery program.
- 3. Payment for requests that are approved will be made in advance of the start of the school year.
- 4. Yearly tuition will be based on the per pupil expenditure and the individual needs of the student for the appropriate category (ies) as provided by the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE). The DESE determines the per pupil expenditure for the North Middlesex Regional School District by July 1 of each year.

Once accepted for admissions, under the provisions of policy JFBB, the student is entitled to remain in the district until graduation from high school, provided the tuition payments are current.
