### Dear Families,

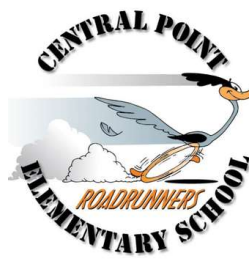
We are so excited to welcome you to CPE for the 2023-2024 school year! We have been busy preparing for our students to arrive on campus starting Tuesday, September. 5th (Grades 1-5).

Kindergarten students will hear from their teachers prior to their first day. Parents may park their cars and walk students to their classrooms **on the first day of school** or drop off students in the round about. Our doors open at 7:30 AM; **students may be walked to class at 7:45**, and class begins at 7:55. Please check your

ParentVue for your student's bus route. After the first day of school, students must be dropped off at the front of the school.

**Student Drop off and Dismissal**

- Student drop off will begin at 7:30am. Please do not drop off earlier than 7:30 as there will be no supervision. Parents may use the drop off loop in front of the school office (please pull as far forward as possible) or the Bush St. drop off location by the playground.
- If you need to pick up your child early from school, please call the front office and we will arrange to have your student up at the office at the requested time. 541-494-6507
- You will need to communicate your student's dismissal plan to their teacher by the first day of school. Any changes to the dismissal plan must go through the front office.
- Bus routes should be available now in ParentVue at the bottom of the Student Information section.

**New Doorbell Feature**

To the left of our front doors is a doorbell for your use during the school day. As a new safety feature, the front doors of CPE will remain locked throughout the day. If you need to enter the school, please use the doorbell, and we will buzz you in.

**Classroom Placement**

- Classroom teacher assignments grades 1-5 are finished, and your student's teacher can be found in ParentVue under Class Schedule. You should also receive communication from your student's teacher prior to the first day of school.
- Kindergarten classroom placements will be available on Thursday, Sept. 7. All kindergarten families will have been called by kindergarten teachers.

## Attendance Matters

CPE has set a goal this year for 92% attendance for all students! Please help us in achieving this goal. For trimester one, each student will need to attend 52/57 days in order for us to hit our goal! We understand kiddos get sick, and please do keep kids home when they have fevers, vomiting and other flu-like symptoms. ## Dress for Success!

As we get going this year, it is important to review how to dress in a safe, respectful and responsible manner while at school. The school dress code is in the student handbook, posted on-line and available in the front office for review. Teachers will be reviewing the highlights of the dress code with students in class, but we rely on you to partner with us to minimize distractions, maintain safety and a high degree of respect by following the dress code. Here are some general guidelines to review with your child:

- **Flip flop shoes without a heel strap are not allowed**
- Longer shorts are preferred (minimum 3 inches from the knee is a general guide)
- Undergarments should be covered at all times
- Backless tops, mesh tops, **spaghetti strap tops & halter tops**, are not permitted.
- Clothing should not have inappropriate logos, sayings, advertisements etc.
- We ask that students do not wear make-up.

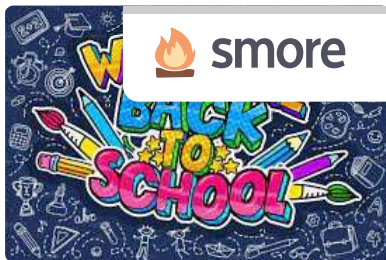
