

OSAS Statewide Testing in Oregon

CPE families, we will conduct our annual OSAS, Essential Skills testing for grades 3-5 beginning in April. While these tests are used to determine the effectiveness of the school's instruction as a whole, the test also prepares our students for the exam they will have to take and pass in high school in order to graduate. 
