






District Enrollment Overview






Elementary Enrollment Overview






Middle School Enrollment Overview




Facility Priorities Identified through Bond Process

- MS Renovation / Expansion 77% support
- Secure entrance at ES and MS 72% support
- Kitchen and cafeteria upgrades 79% support

53.2% APPROVAL (REQUIRES 60%)






Kitchen + Cafeteria Upgrades

The kitchen and cafeteria was part of the original 1969 / 1970 building project.

Since then, the facility has over doubled in size, has added an elementary school and high school, and is still operating out of the original kitchen.


This has created challenges with operations, flow, programming, and student interactions.







Kitchen + Cafeteria Addition

- Construct new kitchen and multi-purpose cafeteria addition that will double as a storm shelter
- Remodel existing kitchen into classrooms (+2)
- Remodel public restrooms to be ADA compliant
- Allows new kitchen to be constructed while existing kitchen remains operational.
- Alleviates congestion challenges at existing kitchen, and would allow for more efficient lunch sections.
- Creates new thru street to enhance vehicle traffic






