



THE OREGON STATE SEAL OF BILITERACY

The Oregon State Seal of Biliteracy (OSSB) and the Oregon State Seal of Multiliteracy (OSSM) have the following two qualifying *criteria for high school students graduating in 2023:

* Meet all graduation requirements

*Score at the Intermediate High on language assessments in all four language domains If English is one of the languages used, select and pass either the State ELA Summative, another approved assessment or portfolio.

QUALIFYING ASSESSMENTS:

- ACTFL Intermediate High on rubric
 - o AAPPL, CLEP, SLIP
 - o OPI need additional reading/writing
 - AJA Tamil
- ALTA
- AP Language & Culture
- AP LIT need additional listening/speaking
- Bridges Oregon ASL
- IR
- STAMP 4S and STAMP 2S (when no 4-domain assessment is available)
- Portfolio 4 domains, ACTFL rubric
- Tribal assessment and letter
- Willamette Promise

PROCESS:

- Complete or update the Notification Form from OSSB website and submit to ODE
- 2. Create a plan to communicate to all students
- 3. Assess students in two or more languages
- 4. Collect required data and submit to ODE via Consolidate Collections/Biliteracy Seal Data Collection and, via Secure File Transfer for specific spelling of student names
- 5. Receive certificates and seals by mail
- 6. Affix the sticker for the Seal of Biliteracy to the students' diplomas
- 7. Award certificate as district determines
- 8. Record the Biliteracy Seal on student transcripts
- 9. Celebrate students



K-12 DATA SUBMISSION TIMELINE

Fall 2022:

- Opens Sept. 8
- Closes Oct. 14

Spring 2023:

- Opens April 20
- Closes May 5

Fall 2023:

- Opens Sept. 7
- Closes Oct. 13
