Dear Parents,

According to Pennsylvania Law, nonpublic school children are entitled to transportation to nonpublic schools as follows:

- 1. A district, which provides transportation for resident public school students, must also make identical provisions for the transportation of resident nonpublic school students according to the nonpublic school calendar.
- 2. Transportation for nonpublic school students must be provided to and from the nonpublic school in which the student is enrolled, even if the nonpublic school is located outside the district so long as the distance is not more than 10 miles beyond the district boundaries. (NOTE: This distance may be in excess of 10 miles from a student's home.)
- 3. A district may transport children who live along hazardous routes even though the children live within walking distance of the school.

If you think you are eligible for transportation and desire it for the next school year, please complete the request form below and return it to school immediately. Thank you!

Solar Eclipse

On April 8, 2024, a total solar eclipse will cross North America, passing over Mexico, the United States and Canada. A total solar eclipse happens when the moon passes between the sun and earth, completely blocking the face of the sun. The sky will darken as if it were dawn or dusk.

The total solar eclipse will begin over the South Pacific Ocean. Weather permitting, the first location that will experience totality is Mexico's Pacific coast at around 11:07 PDT. The path will then continue into Texas and travel through Oklahoma, Arkansas, Missouri, Illinois, Kentucky, Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania, New York, Vermont, New Hampshire and Maine.


Safety Tips for Viewing the Solar Eclipse

• The only way to safely look directly at an eclipsed sun is through special-purpose solar filters, such as "eclipse glasses" or hand-held solar viewers.

Filters should comply with the safety requirements of the ISO 12312-2 international standared for direct viewing of the sun. The American Astronomical Society provides information for safe viewing and has a list of manufacturers that provide viewing glasses that meet the safety requirements of the ISO 12312-2. Please visit https://eclipse.aas.org/eye-safety/viewers_filters

- Always inspect your solar filter before use; if scratched or damaged, discard it. Read and follow any instructions on or packaged with filter.
- Always supervise children using eclipse glasses and solar filters.
- Stand still and cover your eyes with your eclipse glasses or solar viewer before looking up at the sun. After glancing at the eclipsed sun, turn away and remove your filter –do not remove it while looking at the eclipsed sun.
- Do not look at the eclipsed sun through an unfiltered camera, telescope, binoculars, or other optical device. Similarly, do not look at the eclipsed sun through a camera, a telescope, binoculars, or any other optical device while using your eclipse glasses or hand held solar viewer –the concentrated solar rays will damage the filter and enter your eye(s), causing serious injury.
- Sunglasses are never a substitute for eclipse glasses.

Children that are not age appropriate or mature enough to know the importance of following the viewing guidelines should not be permitted to view the eclipsed sun.

ROOKIE DIVISION (\$65)

4 6 5 YEAR OLDS The Rookie Flags division is considered an instructional program, and will be played 5 vs 5 or 6 vs 6. Similar to NFL Play 60 style rules. Players will be provided protective soft helmet, "flags" and a uniform.

FLAG DIVISION (\$75)

6 & 7 YEAR OLDS The Flags division is considered an instructional program, but is now competitive as of 2018. Players will be provided protective soft helmet, "flags" and a uniform.

JUNIOR VARSITY (\$100)

8 & 9 YEAR OLDS

The 100 lbs. division is a full contact tackle team that wears full protective equipment. Age/Weight - 8 and 9 year old's: under 100lbs to run the ball and a 130lbs cap.

VARSITY (\$100) 10, 11, & 12 YEAR OLDS

The 120 lbs. division is a full contact tackle team that wears full protective equipment. Age/Weight - 10, 11 and 12 (6th grade) year olds under 120lbs to run the ball and a 150lbs cap. 12 year olds in 7th grade is *100lbs max
