



SAINT OF THE WEEK



St. Francis of Paola

St. Francis of Paola (1416-1507) was born in Calabria, Italy, to a husband and wife known for their holiness. After suffering childlessness for many years, his parents had recourse to prayer, especially the intercession of St. Francis of Assisi. They eventually had three children, and the eldest, Francis, was named after St. Francis in thanksgiving for his birth. Francis of Paola grew in sanctity, and after having a vision of St. Francis, he spent a year in a Franciscan convent to fulfill a vow his parents had made to the saint. After his time there, he returned to his parents and accompanied them on a pilgrimage to Assisi. Upon returning home, Francis retired to a private spot on his parents' estate to live as a hermit. He later moved his dwelling to a lonely cave by the seashore, living there in prayer, solitude, and mortification for six years. Disciples gradually came to him to imitate his manner of life, so many that St. Francis of Paola, with the bishop's permission, built a monastery and church to accommodate them. He later obtained permission from the Holy See to found a new religious order called the Minims, or "The Least," as they were to live hidden lives of poverty, abstinence, and humility. St. Francis of Paola became famous and was sought out by others for his prophecies and miracles. He spent the last three months of his life in solitude in preparation for his death. On Good Friday, after receiving Last Rites, he died while the Passion of Christ was read to him aloud.



SANTO DE LA SEMANA



San Francisco de Paula

San Francisco de Paola (1416-1507) nació en Calabria, Italia, de un matrimonio conocido por su santidad. Después de sufrir durante muchos años la falta de hijos, sus padres recurrieron a la oración, especialmente a la intercesión de San Francisco de Asís. Finalmente tuvieron tres hijos, y el mayor, Francisco, recibió el nombre de San Francisco en acción de gracias por su nacimiento. Francisco de Paola creció en santidad y, después de tener una visión de San Francisco, pasó un año en un convento franciscano para cumplir un voto que sus padres le habían hecho al santo. Después de su estancia allí, regresó con sus padres y los acompañó en una peregrinación a Asís. Al regresar a casa, Francisco se retiró a un lugar privado en la finca de sus padres para vivir como ermitaño. Posteriormente trasladó su morada a una cueva solitaria a la orilla del mar, donde vivió en oración, soledad y mortificación durante seis años. Poco a poco acudieron a él discípulos para imitar su forma de vida, tantos que San Francisco de Paula, con el permiso del obispo, construyó un monasterio y una iglesia para acogerlos. Más tarde obtuvo permiso de la Santa Sede para fundar una nueva orden religiosa llamada los Mínimos, o "Los Menores", ya que debían vivir vidas ocultas de pobreza, abstinencia y humildad. San Francisco de Paula se hizo famoso y muchos lo buscaban por sus profecías y milagros. Pasó los últimos tres meses de su vida en soledad preparándose para su muerte. El Viernes Santo, después de recibir la extremaunción, murió mientras le leían en voz alta la Pasión de Cristo.





SJV's Scholar Dollars through the Cathedral Gift Card Program is a valuable program that earns tuition credits for you. There are no hidden costs, simply use the gift cards that you purchase from SJV's Scholar Dollars for your everyday shopping. SJV's Scholar Dollars are also great for gift giving. This valuable year-round (May 1st – April 30th) program for our school is known as SJV's Scholar Dollars through the Cathedral Gift Card Program, formally known as Cathedral Cash. Parents and families can purchase gift cards from Scholar Dollars for local businesses, grocery stores, restaurants, and large department stores. Participation in this program is strongly encouraged. The Family Activity Fee is added to your tuition bill, but when you purchase SJV's Scholar Dollars, you can earn that back, plus more in tuition credits. Your participation in SJV's Scholar Dollars also helps support school-wide initiatives. For every dollar you spend on SJV's Scholar Dollars gift cards, you will earn a percentage that goes directly towards your tuition credit. Next to each merchant on the gift card list is a percentage - you earn half of that, and the other half goes directly towards the school budget. Please call the main office at 610-435-8981 for details. Scholar Dollars through the Cathedral Gift Card Program is a program that directly benefits student's tuition and SJVRS.

Scholar Dollars Gift Cards are available everyday through the Scholar Dollars Envelope. Complete the order form (white envelope) and send it to school Monday through Friday in the Scholar Dollars Envelope (yellow plastic reusable envelope). The order will be filled, and the gift cards will come home the same day with your child. **Checks should be made payable to Cathedral St Catharine.** To participate complete registration form below.

Monthly sales are sent out through school communications and our parish bulletins. The dates that the sale is due and when it will be available are located on the form. Simply complete the form and send it in along with payment. Your gift cards will be sent home with your child through school.
