CHS Mission

AVID is an acronym for Advancement Via Individual Determination. AVID's mission, and our mission as a school, is to close the opportunity gap by preparing all students for college readiness and success in a global society.

Important Reminder for Tuesday, April 9th

- ★ 9th/10th Grades take PreACT/Forward Test
- **★** No School for Juniors, UNLESS making up the ACT they missed on March 12th.
- ★ Senior Day! Seniors MUST attend during the planned morning session to complete required tasks.

9th & 10th grade students take the PreACT on Tuesday, April 9th

9th graders will take only the PreACT and will finish at approx. 11:00 am.

10th graders will take the PreACT and Forward tests and will be finished at approx. 12:15.

Students who receive testing accommodations will be released at a later time, likely between 12:30 and 1:00 PM. Sack Lunches will be provided for students wanting to take one when they leave.

Bus transportation will still operate at the normal time. The library will be open for students after testing for those waiting for a ride or buses.

It is important that all 9th and 10th graders be in their assigned testing rooms before 8:00 on test day so testing can begin on time to end at the scheduled time.

Students will test with their Advisory Teacher, but will likely be in a different room.

Students MUST bring their Chromebooks fully charged and bring their charger on test day just in case.

What is the PreACT & Forward Test?

The PreACT is an online test using student Chromebooks and has been adopted as the statewide assessment for students in grades 9 and 10. Taking the PreACT allows teachers and parents to monitor student growth as they move closer to graduation. Additionally, it assists students in reaching their educational goals by providing detailed feedback on strengths and weaknesses in core content areas. The PreACT measures achievement in English, math, reading, and science and directly prepares students for the ACT that students will take Junior Year and can be used for college entrance and possible scholarships. It is very important that students do their best to measure their college readiness.

The Forward test is an online test using student Chromebooks and tests 10th graders statewide in the area of Social Studies as that is not included in the PreACT.

Senior Day April 9th

Seniors will not be attending classes at Craig on April 9, 2024 due to our PreACT test date for 9th and 10th grade students, however, they will participate in Senior Day activities during the planned date.
