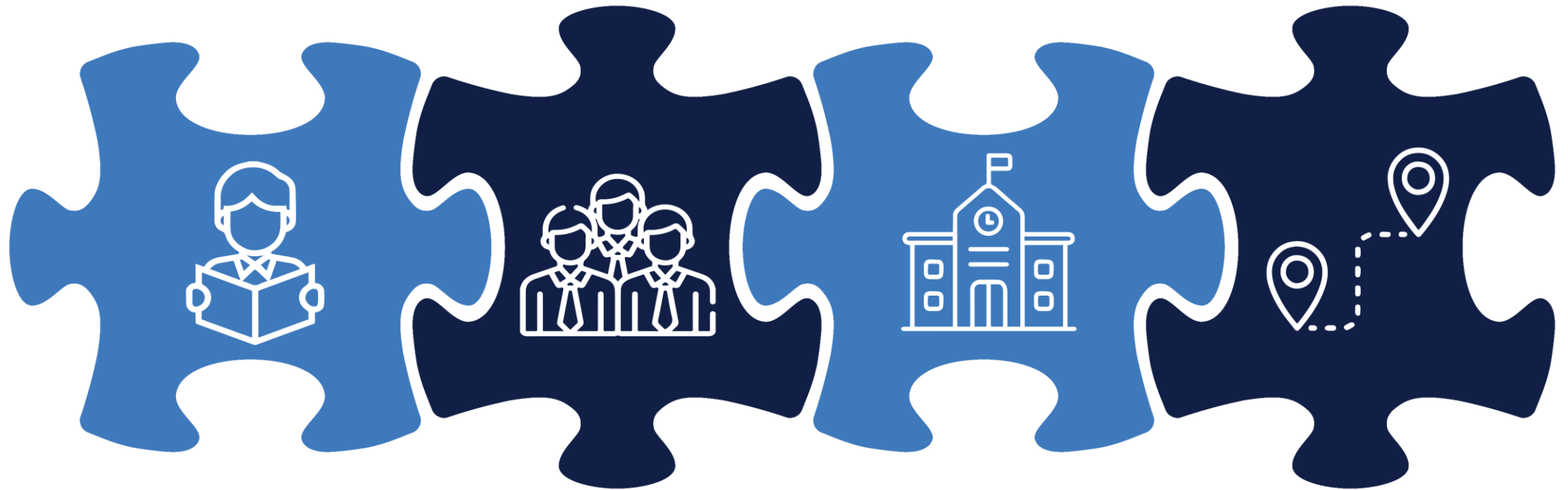

FAST FACTS ABOUT THE BOND

- 1 SISD will pay approximately **\$10,000,000 out of fund balance** towards Bond Projects.
- 2 SISD School Board approved **\$650,000 for turf installation** in May separate from the
- 3 ^{Bond.}
Bond prioritizes **SAFETY AND NEEDS** versus wants.
- 4 Sweeny City Council approved variances for parking and restroom requirements to keep the Stadium Project **as affordable as possible**.
- 5 Over \$600,000 will be invested into **water fountains district-wide** to ensure they are refrigerated and filtered.
- 6 **Tax rate WILL NOT increase.**

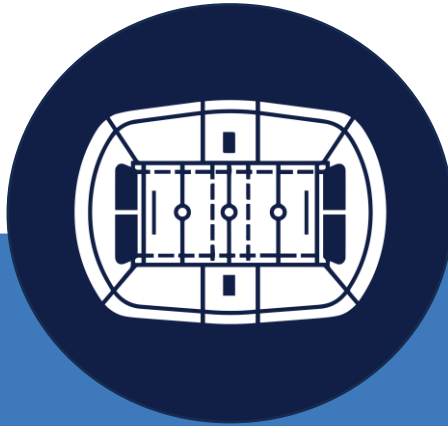
BUILDING THE BOND

PROPOSITION A

\$21,000,000

The issuance of \$21,000,000 for the design, construction, acquisition, rehabilitation, renovation, expansion, improvement, and equipment of athletic stadium facilities in the district, and the levy and imposition of taxes sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds and the costs of any credit agreements. This is a property tax increase.



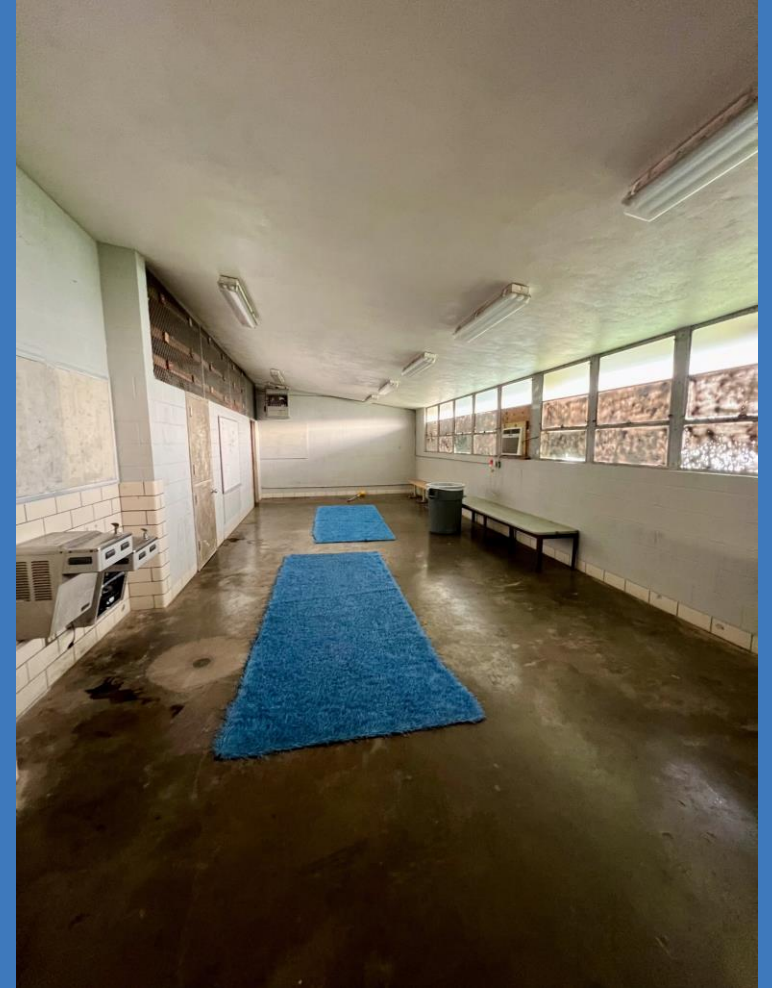
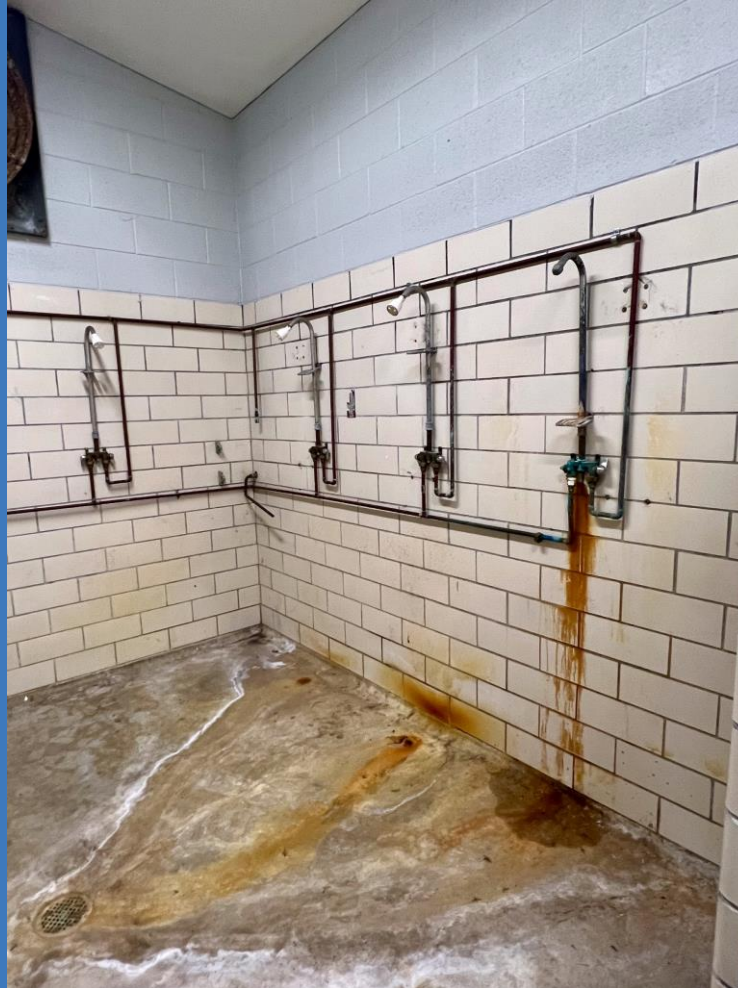
PROPOSITION B

\$21,000,000

The issuance of \$21,000,000 for the design, construction, acquisition, rehabilitation, renovation, expansion, improvement, and equipment of school buildings in the district, including construction of a new field house and renovations and improvements to district gymnasium facilities, and the levy and imposition of taxes sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds and the costs of any credit agreements. This is a property tax increase.

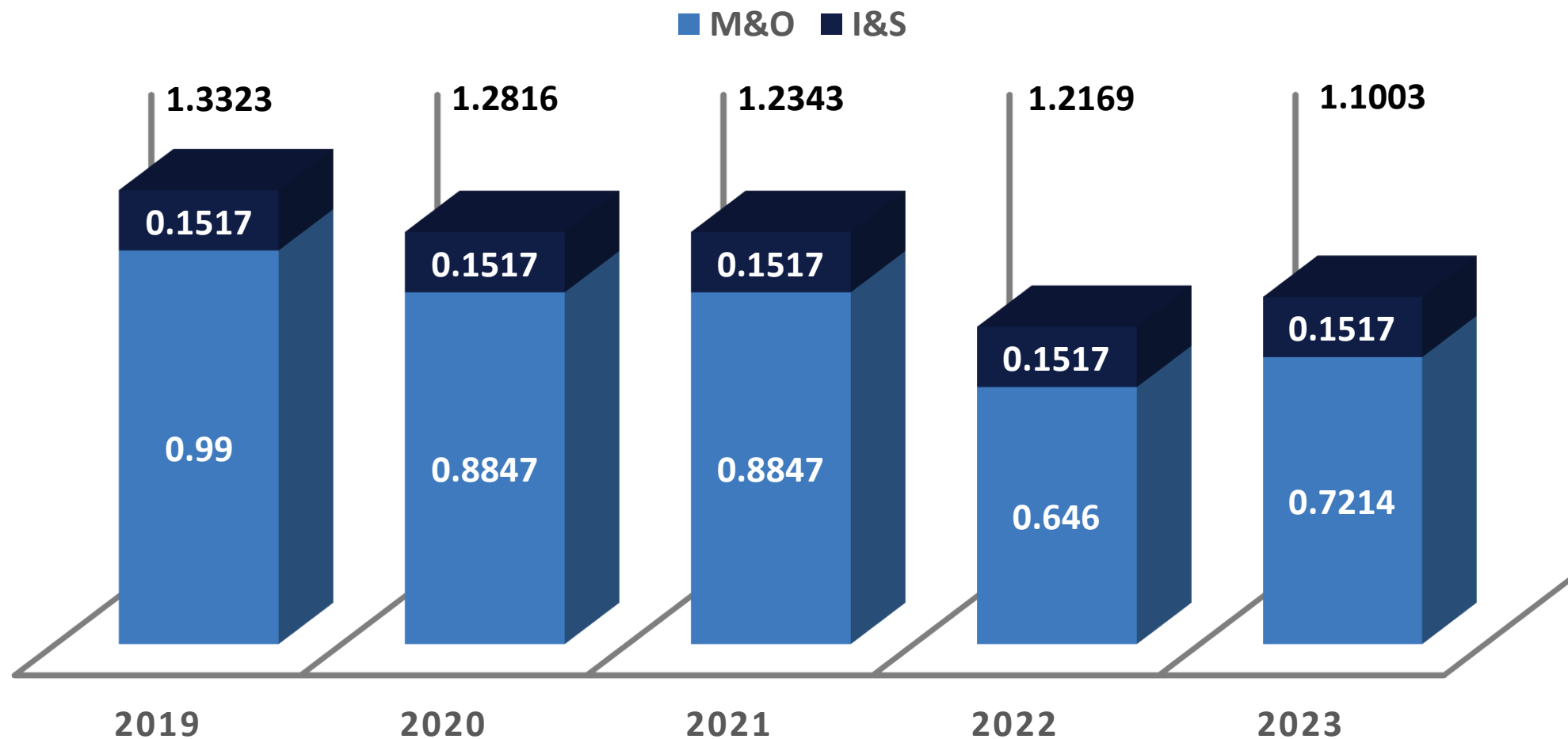
For Sweeny ISD Taxpayers

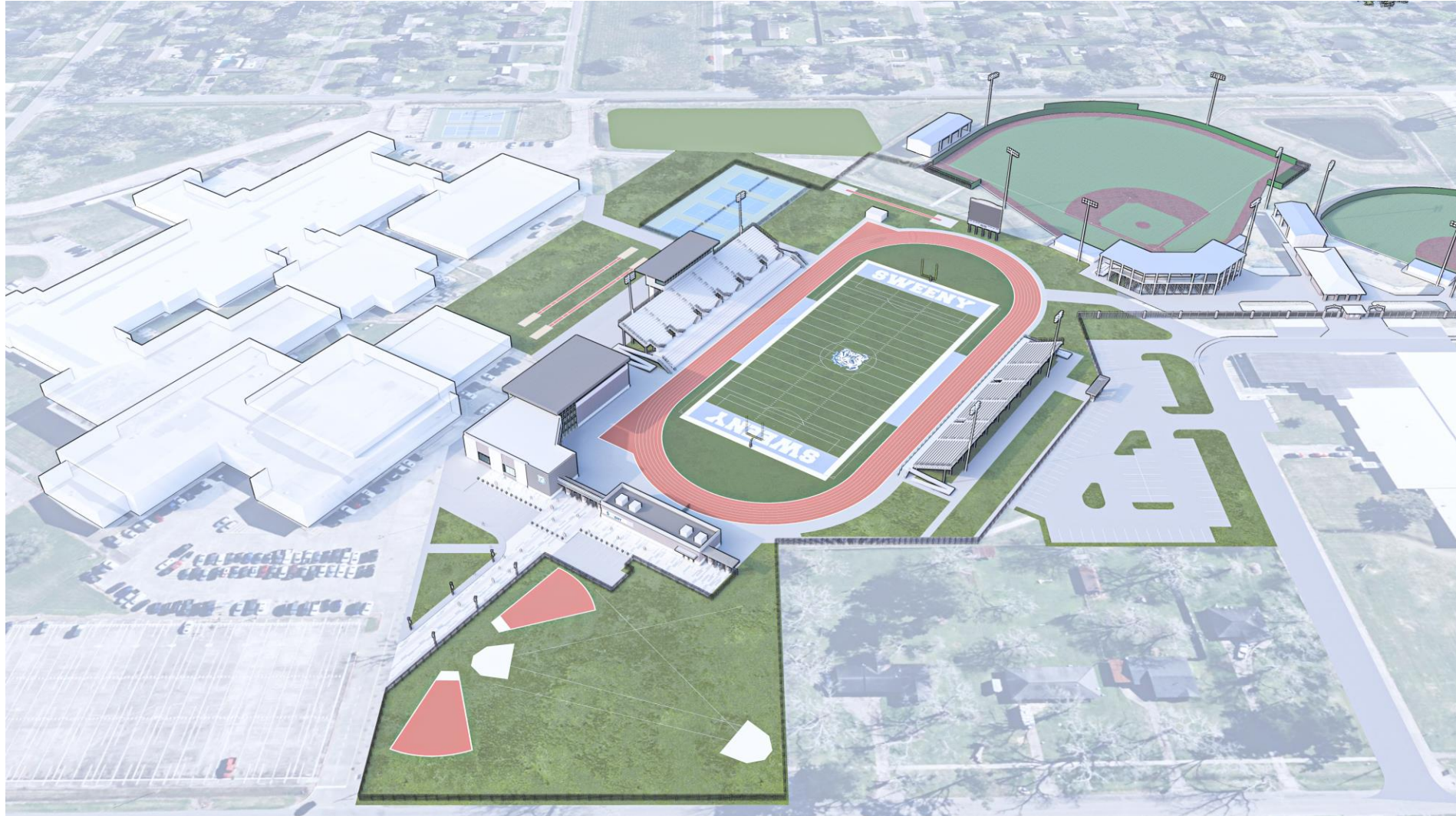

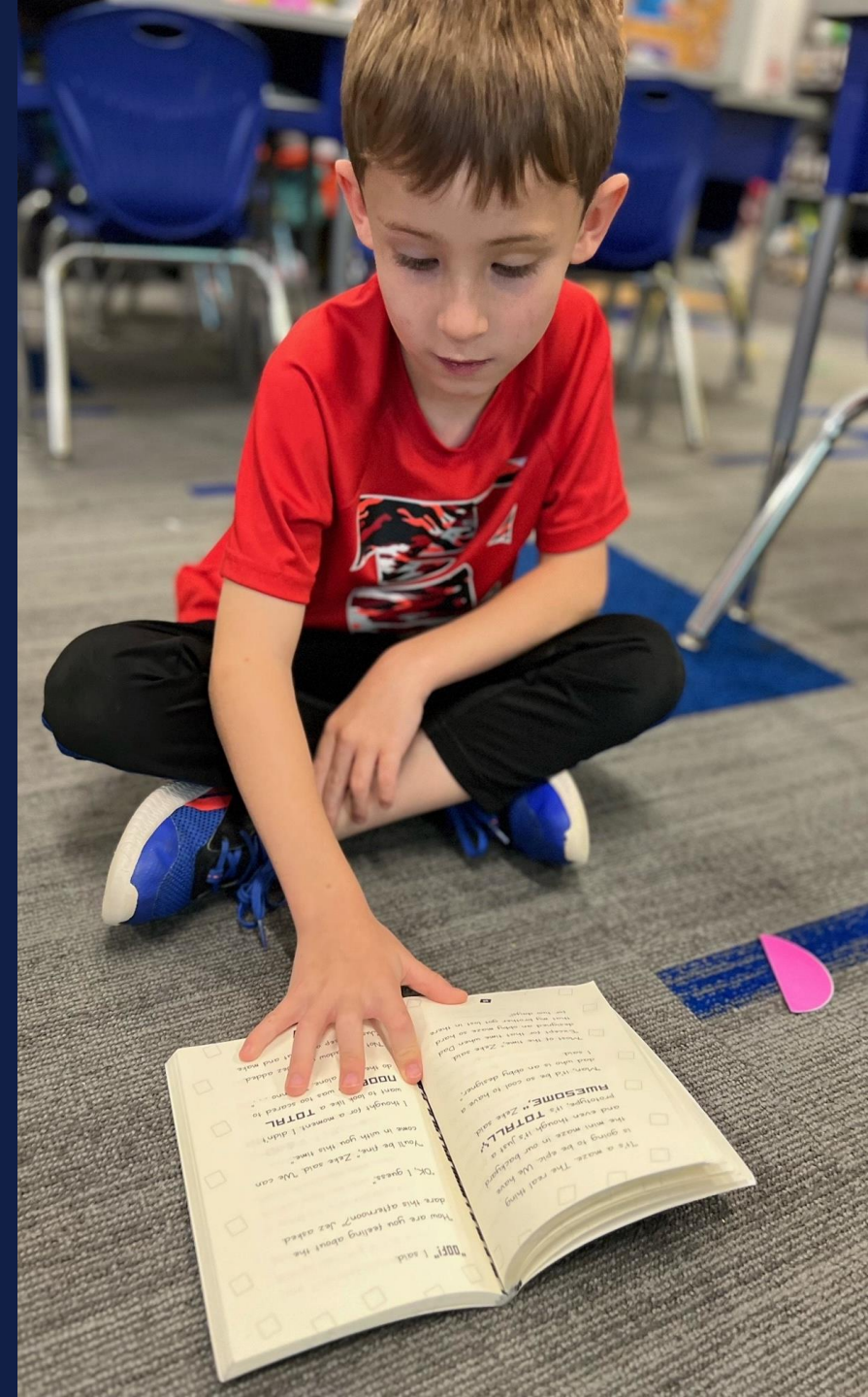
