English Language Learners

Buffalo Creek offers a one-way dual-language program. In the early grades, students in bilingual classes receive primary instruction in Spanish while developing their English language skills. Starting in the third grade, the primary language of instruction shifts to English, and students build on their Spanish language skills to become valuable bilingual learners.

Special Education

"All means all" at Buffalo Creek Elementary. Students receiving special education services have access to the school's full educational program and all opportunities available to general education students. Specialized education through Life Skills and APPLE (Autism Program Preparing Learners for Excellence) classes as well as in-class assistance is provided. Other supports available include dyslexia interventions, speech therapy, physical therapy and occupational therapy per each student's individualized education plan.

Physical Education

The health-fitness program is one of the most beloved elements of BCE's instructional program. All students learn developmentally appropriate health, safety and fitness skills in a variety of activities throughout the year. Students participate in individual and team activities, tasks and challenges. Through health-fitness classes, students have the opportunity to develop physical, social and academic skills fundamental to a well-rounded education.

Fine Arts

At Buffalo Creek Elementary, music and art instruction are essential to the development of creative thinking and the self-expression of students. Many opportunities to publicly perform and proudly exhibit art occur throughout the school year.
