Any student interested in attending an event after school hours must be accompanied by an adult.

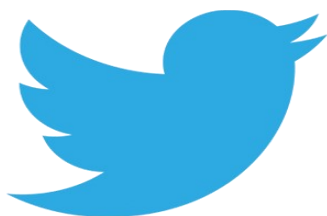
In addition to discussing academic performance with your child, please be sure to check teacher websites and individual newsletters.
