It will be the duty of the Superintendent to administer the schools within the Gulfport School District and to implement the decisions of the Board of Trustees. '37-9-14 (1)

The Board hereby delegates to the Superintendent the function of specifying required actions and designing the detailed arrangements under which the schools will be operated except when specific state or federal laws or rules require the Board to adopt such rules or when the Board or Superintendent consider such adoptions desirable.

In the development of administrative regulations, the Superintendent will involve, at the planning stage, those who would be affected by such rules, including staff members, students, parents, and the public. The Superintendent will inform the Board of such counsel in presenting any regulations for Board approval.

The Superintendent will devise appropriate means for disseminating regulations to the staff members, students, and/or members of the public who are affected by them. Members of the Board will receive copies of all new or revised district-wide administrative regulations.
