The Superintendent as chief executive officer has the responsibility for carrying out, through administrative rules, the policies established by the Board of Trustees. The policies developed by the Board and the administrative rules established to implement policy are designed to increase the effectiveness and efficiency of the Gulfport School District.

Administrators are responsible for informing their staff of existing policies and administrative rules in a positive manner and for seeing that they are implemented in the spirit intended. Disregard for Board policy and administrative rules may be interpreted as insubordination and/or willful neglect of duty. The Superintendent has the power and the authority under the provisions of '37-9-59 to dismiss or suspend any certified employee for insubordination and/or neglect of duty.
