The Board of Trustees requires, as a minimum, that the Superintendent will have earned a master's degree, or higher, from an accredited college or university, with a major in education administration and supervision. The Superintendent shall have at least six (6) years of successful experience in the public schools, with at least three (3) years of administrative experience as a school building principal; the remaining experience may be as a school building principal, assistant superintendent, or superintendent. The superintendent will possess an administrator's certificate that is valid in the State of Mississippi
