The Board of Trustees believes that any student who is capable of and wishes to do college-level work while in high school should be permitted to do so.

Any 10th, 11th or 12th grade student whose admission to a college-level course is recommended by his/her counselor and teacher and who is able to meet those criteria established by the Gulfport School District may enroll in a course at the college or university of his/her choice for college credit. Should the student wish to receive high school credit for the course, he/she may request permission from the Principal, through the counselor, to apply the course toward high school graduation requirements.
