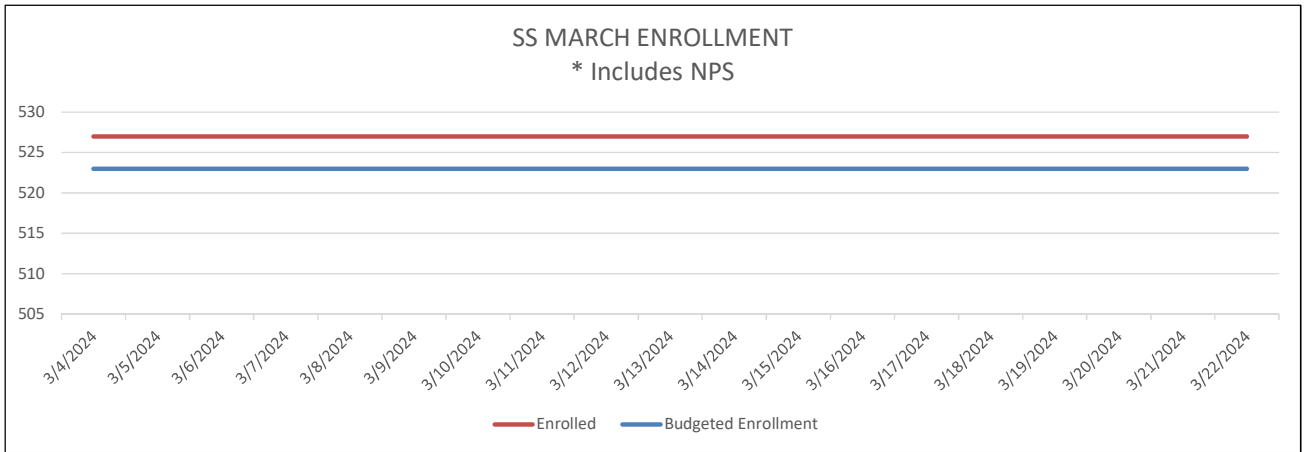

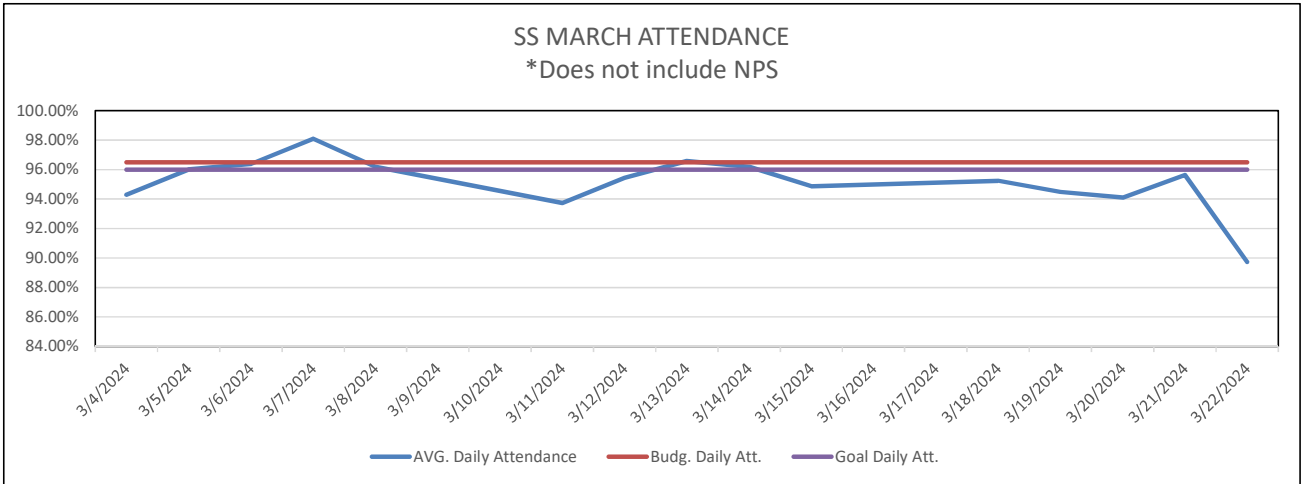

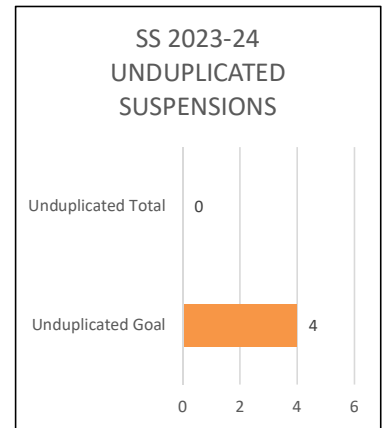
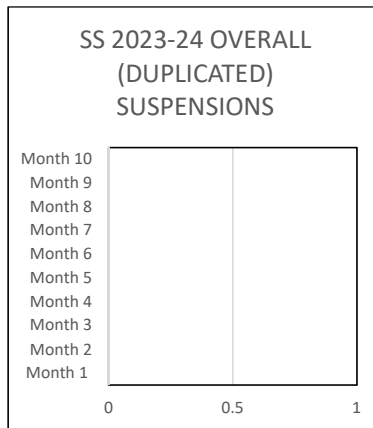
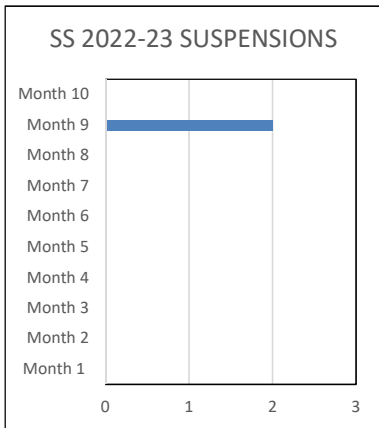
ENROLLMENT CHARTS
