Enrollment Deadlines and FAFSA Delays

The Department of Education told colleges that FAFSA applications will not be sent to colleges until the middle of March, or maybe later. Students also will not get correction notifications until mid-March. Delays with FAFSA processing means your Student Aid Report (SAR) may not be sent to you until April or May. The SAR provides high-level estimates of your eligibility for federal student aid including grants, loans, and work study. The SAR will be emailed to you from noreply@fafsa.gov (if you provided your email address) or mailed to you and the colleges you indicated when you completed the FAFSA. Once your college receives your SAR, they will process it and mail you an award letter. The award letter shows the financial aid package you are eligible to receive including scholarships from the college/university, grants, loans, and work study. The award letter will not show any private scholarships you win while still in high school. Information about private scholarships won (from Crater Foundation and any others you win that are not associated with the college you are enrolling in) should be sent to the college/university once you've committed to attend

.

Seniors should still complete their FAFSA, OSAC, and Oregon Promise applications right away. Students can submit OSAC and Oregon Promise before finishing FAFSA but will not be awarded anything until their FAFSA is processed.

- Freshman applications are closed for the Corvallis campus but are open for OSU-Cascades.
- Document Deadline is now Feb. 23 (submit transcripts and other requested documents through Beaver Basecamp)
- Presidential Scholars deadline has not changed.
- Early ScholarDollars & Financial Need Application Deadline is now Feb. 29 (scholarship application deadline). <u>Please apply even if your FAFSA has not yet been processed.</u>
- OSU offers admission-based scholarships including the Finley Academic Excellence Scholarship, the OSU Diversity Achievement Scholarship, the Provost Scholarship, and the WUE Scholarship for transfer students. - FAFSA priority submission deadline (date you should have completed the FAFSA by) is now March 31.
- Extending Enrollment Confirmation Deadline to June 1 (for first-year freshmen) at Corvallis and Bend campus. OSU will work with students who have challenges that make even a June 1st commitment to attend unfeasible. Jun 1, 2024 is the date seniors should have their \$200 deposit turned into Beaver Basecamp. You can request a deposit waiver mid/late April after FAFSA information has been sent to OSU.
- Housing contract applications will begin being processed May 2nd (for those who confirmed enrollment by the original May 1 deadline). They will continue to process through the June 1 deadline.
- If you confirm enrollment and pay your deposit before receiving your financial aid award letter from OSU and realize you cannot attend due to financial reasons, you can still cancel your confirmation and get a refund until June 1st deadline.
- Enrollment Options for Late Applicants:

- o E-campus
- Attend OSU Cascades and apply to transfer to Corvallis when room opens
- Defer a term (Winter/Spring enrollment in Corvallis with required housing is based on availability)
- Start at another college and transfer
- o Exceptions to this list
 - If student lives within the 30 mile radius and is living at home
 - Student has been out of high school for 1+ years

Please make sure to track when your admission and financial aid applications are due for the college/university you plan to attend. Most schools require a separate financial aid application (in addition to completing the FAFSA).

- Oregon State Corvallis and Bend = Feb 1 (Priority financial aid deadline Feb. 28)
- Portland State = Aug. 1 (Priority financial aid deadline June 1)
- Southern Oregon = Feb. 1 (Priority financial aid deadline March 1)
- University of Oregon = Jan. 15 (Priority financial aid deadline March 1)
- Western Oregon = Feb. 1 (Priority financial aid deadline Feb. 15)
- Oregon Tech = Nov. 1 is priority but still accepting applications (Priority financial aid deadline March 1)
