Online options available

Direct Course Placement

Ways to Place (at LHS): Must have completed 10th grade

For ENGL 101 / THTR 101

HS unweighted GPA 2.5+

For MATH 113

HS unweighted GPA of 2.6 plus ALG II C or higher

Additional ways to place:

AP Exam Score 3+

SAT = ERBW 480 + (ENGL 101)

SAT = 530 + (MATH 113)

ACT 21+ / 24

- Placement testing for any student not meeting direct course placement
- Placement testing for ALL 9th / 10th grade students.

- Complete (CCPS) Dual Enrollment Request Form
- Register
- Attend orientation

Scheduling

- Carroll Community College
 - April for Summer / Fall courses
 - November for Winter / Spring courses
- 9th & 10th grade elective courses
- 11th & 12th grade electives and/or graduation required courses
- Register for correct course!
 - Example HIST 101 vs HIST 110

College Class at Liberty

- · Will follow all College policies and rules
- Use Blackboard (NO home access)

- Cannot share grades or talk with parents directly
- Will receive mid-term grades

Carroll Scholarships

Jump Start Award - \$500

High school students who, while dually enrolled at CCC, have earned a minimum of six (6) credits with a 3.0 GPA or higher are eligible to receive this scholarship when they enroll full-time in credit classes the semester after they graduate high school.

Rising STEM Scholar Award

- Students who graduate from the PLTW program offered at CCCTC receive \$500 per semester for two years.

- Plus books!


Dual Enrollment @ CCPS
