Return them to your campus principal by **April 30, 2024** or mail to PO Box 656, Keene, Texas 76059. The campus committee will review, upon completion of the required documents, whether your child has met the requirements to enroll at Keene ISD. Limited Open Enrollment Program

On December 16, 2013, the Keene ISD Board of Trustees approved a Limited Open Enrollment Program for non-resident students who desire to attend class in Keene ISD. There is no required tuition or payment. Approval of Limited Open Enrollment will be based on the following:

1. The current enrollment at the particular grade level or class as well as any special program requirement of the student seeking admission. Consideration shall include the effect of additional students in that grade or program, facilities, staffing needs and the education opportunity of resident students.
2. The disciplinary record of the student seeking admission.
3. The attendance record of the student seeking admission.
4. The academic record of the student seeking admission including the student's performance on applicable state-mandated assessments, and/or standardized test (ITBS, etc.) the student's record of promotion to the next grade level and the student's extracurricular record.
5. The parent's compliance with District and Campus policies and regulations.

2. Complete and sign the parent questionnaire and out of district transfer agreement form. Please print the information and return it to the appropriate campus: Keene Elementary (K-5), Summit Leadership Academy (3-5), Keene Jr. High (6-8), Keene High School (9-12) or mail to PO Box 656, Keene, Texas 76059.
