Where: Grand Bohemian Hotel Ballroom (2655 Park Lane, Mountain Brook, AL)

Parking: Please park in any open spot around the hotel in the village. Please be respectful of handicap parking spots and any spot specifically designated for residents that live in the apartments in the same vicinity. Valet parking is available for \$16.00/car per the hotel.

Food: There will be hors d'oeuvres and desserts served at the Grand Bohemian.

Entertainment: DJ Sammy will be the DJ and a Photo Booth will be available in the Ballroom.

Who: Juniors and Seniors

Non JCCHS Students: Students who wish to bring a guest from another school must complete the Guest Approval Form located in the front office. The form must be signed by student, parent/guardian, and guest student's principal and be faxed by the guest's school, back to John Carroll 5 days prior to the dance. JCCHS students are responsible for sharing the dress guidelines with their guests, who must follow the dress guidelines and present a photo ID upon checking in to the dance. Prom Dress Code:

Students are expected to dress in a way that represents the young Christian men and women that they are called to be, and which represents John Carroll Catholic High School in a respectful, modest, and tasteful way. This is considered a formal occasion; tuxedos and long dresses are recommended.

Students should refer to the guidelines in the student handbook for other rules specific to school dances. Students who do not follow the guidelines for dances may lose the privilege of attending future events, be asked to leave the dance, or be asked to cover themselves with an item provided by the school.

DANCES

Dances provide social opportunities for John Carroll students. Only John Carroll students and their approved guests are permitted to attend dances. Students who would like to request a guest attend or who are requesting to invite a non-John Carroll guest must complete the guest form for each dance and submit for approval at least one week prior to the Homecoming dance, the Queen of Hearts dance, and the Prom. If your request is approved, you will receive an email reminding you that you are responsible for ensuring your guest or the person you are hosting understands the John Carroll dress regulations and conduct expectations .

Middle school students are not permitted to attend John Carroll dances. Students should make arrangements to be picked up no later than the posted end time of the dance.

DANCE DRESS REGULATIONS

Ladies

- Dresses and gowns should be no higher than mid-thigh.
- Sides, stomach, and chest area should be covered - No sheer or see-through material can be used and no skin may show
- From the natural waist down must be covered.
- Dresses should not be overly tight or form-fitting.
- Dresses should fit in such a way as to preserve modesty.

Gentlemen

- Gentlemen should wear appropriately dressy clothing to formal school dances, including a suit or a blazer, dress pants or slacks, and dress shirt.
- Meet the grooming standards in the JC student handbook.

Alcohol and Drugs

When purchasing tickets to Prom, you are agreeing to follow the rules set by John Carroll. It is strictly forbidden for students to use, possess, or distribute tobacco, alcohol, vapes and other drugs on school premises, in school-owned vehicles, during any school-sponsored trips or activities, or displayed on social media when representing JCCHS. Failure to abide by these regulations is grounds for disciplinary action.
