There have been a number of tragic incidents in our area and in our state in recent years, and with every event makes me more and more concerned about our students.

Please help partner with us around student safety, and have a conversation with your students about avoiding drugs and alcohol, the dangers of drinking and driving, and what they should do if they face a situation in which they don't feel safe. Please let them know how much we all care about them, and care about their safety and well being. At prom, please know that we will have members of school administration, parent volunteers, and Lafayette Police to greet students on their way into the venue, encourage them to make good choices, and to be there in case students encounter anything that makes them feel unsafe. Student safety is our number one priority, and we appreciate your support with this.

I also highly encourage students to attend the [Centaurus Safe Night After Prom \(CSNAP\)](#). Knowing that we have such a great event for students after our prom puts my mind at ease, and I ask that you check in with your student about attending this fun event that is intended to keep them safe and happy. We are lucky to have a group of incredible parent volunteers that put this event on for our students, and I hope that all students take advantage of this opportunity.

Tickets will be on sale this coming week Monday-Thursday in the cafeteria during lunch periods. It only costs \$5 purchased in advance, while \$10 at the door the night of the event. There are NO added costs; upon entry students there is a ton of entertainment (including pool and ice rink), food, and valuable prizes. 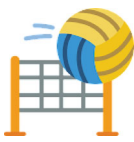

Centaurus Orchestra



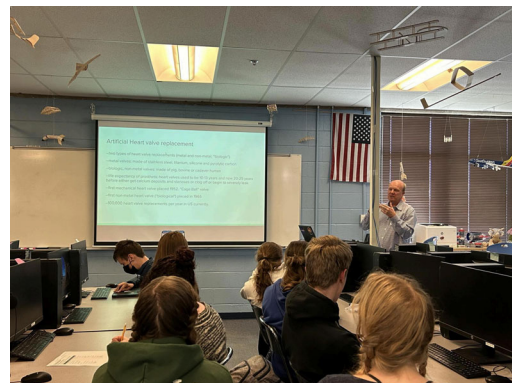
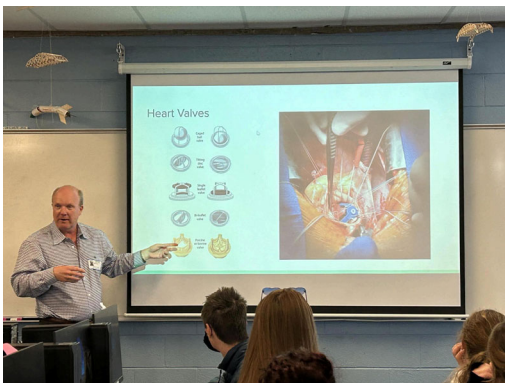

What's Happening in Engineering this week?



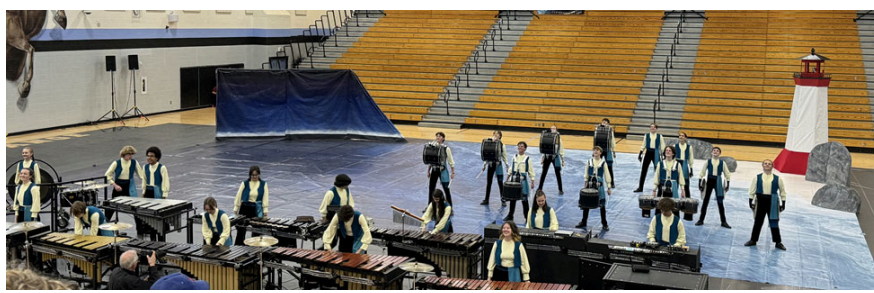
