I hope this letter finds you well. As part of our commitment to ensuring our students' academic success and growth, the River Valley School District will administer the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) this spring. The dates are as follows:

ELA: Grades 3-8 (April 23-25)
Math: Grades 3-8 (April 29-30)
Science: Grades 4 & 8 (May 1)

The PSSA is a standardized assessment administered to students in Pennsylvania public schools. It evaluates students' proficiency in English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science (for specific grade levels) according to state academic standards. The assessments are designed to provide valuable information about student performance and to guide instruction to meet the diverse needs of our learners.

It's important to note that students do not need to study specifically for the PSSA. The assessments are based on the curriculum that students are taught throughout the school year. Our dedicated teachers have been diligently preparing students through everyday instruction to ensure they have the knowledge and skills necessary to succeed.

The purpose of the PSSAs is multifaceted. Primarily, they serve as a tool for assessing individual student achievement and growth and provide valuable data for evaluating school and district performance. Moreover, the results help inform instructional practices and curriculum development to better meet the needs of our students.

PSSAs are required for students in certain grade levels. Specifically, students in grades 3 through 8 are required to participate in English Language Arts and Mathematics assessments. Additionally, Science assessments are administered to students in grades 4 and 8.


