**F. Athletic Director Update**

We are fortunate that we do not have large fees for outside use of pools and golf course; Athletes are trying to improve participation in spirit days – hoping this helps spread school spirit; Updates for Spring Season – All athletes that are headed to Jane Hoover must use sidewalk; \*Parents/spectators should not park in East High Lot until 4 PM due to dismissal. There are parking restrictions along High Street on south side until 4 PM as well. Track team will go to College 2 days per week (school days) – there is a set path for walking

As of last Tuesday, construction is 2 weeks behind; July 25 expected completion date is still set

**G. Team Reports:**

**Softball** – winter workouts are in Middle School gym 2 times per week; National Umpire Clinic was just here (we hosted); Meal was catered: \$1700 profit on food: Due to snow forecasted, they had to operate on a 2 hour delay and lost approx.. \$250 in food sales

**Wrestling** – dual meet; Season Record is 11-6; Finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in Section 2; Have Multiple all-stars; Girls Sectional tournament – two girls qualified for regionals and wrestle next weekend. Francis Burke became our first Section Champ since 2010; Wrestles again to determine if he moves to State Tournament

**Boys Lacrosse** – lifting 2 x's per week; a family/coach/player kick-off dinner in high school cafeteria is next week; trying to get numbers up; working on chicken bbq fundraiser for April

**Swim** – season is coming to a close; took 21 to Leagues; boys placed second (highest we've ever placed); girls placed fifth; 100 backstroke won; boys 400 freestyle relay – won; Next is 12 qualify for Districts; one student is seeded 5<sup>th</sup> in District and another 7<sup>th</sup>

**Tennis** – practices are held at Hempfield Rec

**Boys Volleyball** – first scrimmage in coming up; fundraiser at The Spot - boys created a sandwich called "The Grizzly"; anytime it is ordered, a portion of those profits are shared with the team

**Bowling** – Won Section 2; Districts is this weekend; 1 girl and 4 boys playing in Districts; 2 are in top five as starters in the League; Lancaster County is hosting the National Tournament this year

**Boys Tennis** – not much going on

**Cross-country** – (Mary Checco new rep) not much going on currently; the boys have been running

**Boys Basketball** – ended season on a win; banquet was on Sunday at the Moose Lodge; have extra plasticware if anyone needs it

**Field Hockey** – starting to reconnect; high school team meeting was Feb. 12; winter workouts starting next week in the weight room

**Cheer** – one more competition remains; Reach for the Beach competition is in Ocean City this weekend.
