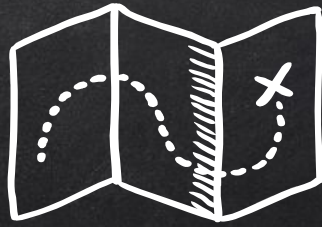

After high school, the majority of SBUSD students continue their education at a college.

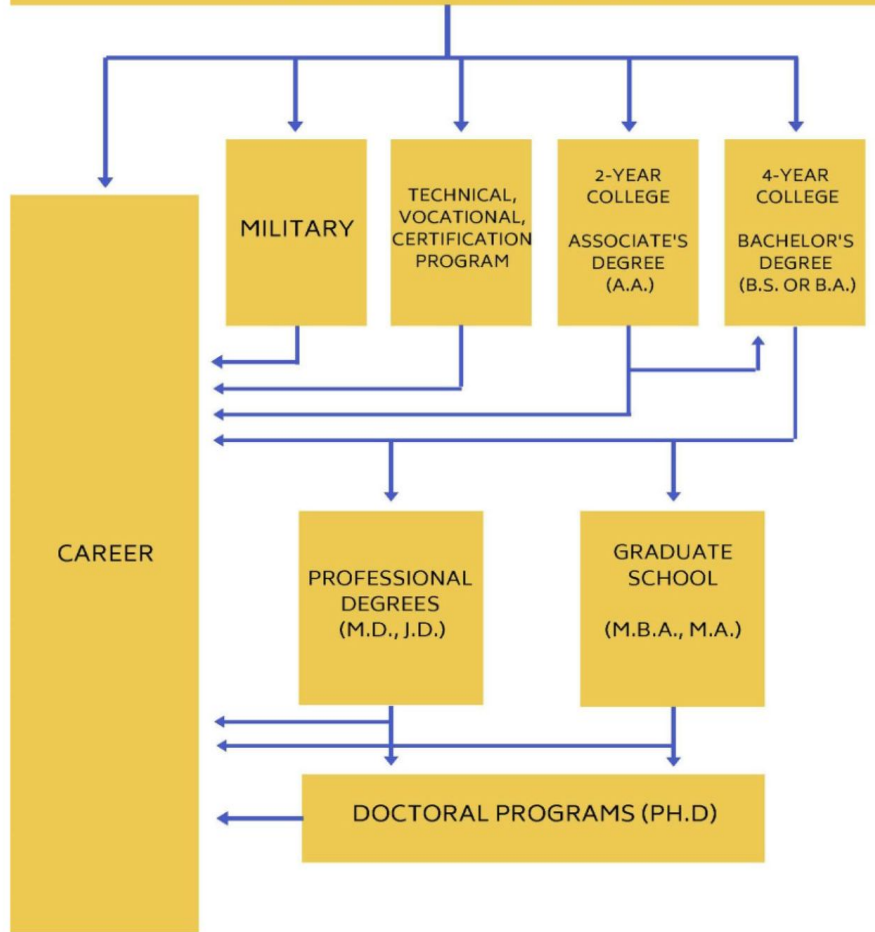
Después de la secundaria, la mayoría de los estudiantes del SBUSD continúan su educación en una universidad.

And eventually, all students will end up in a career.

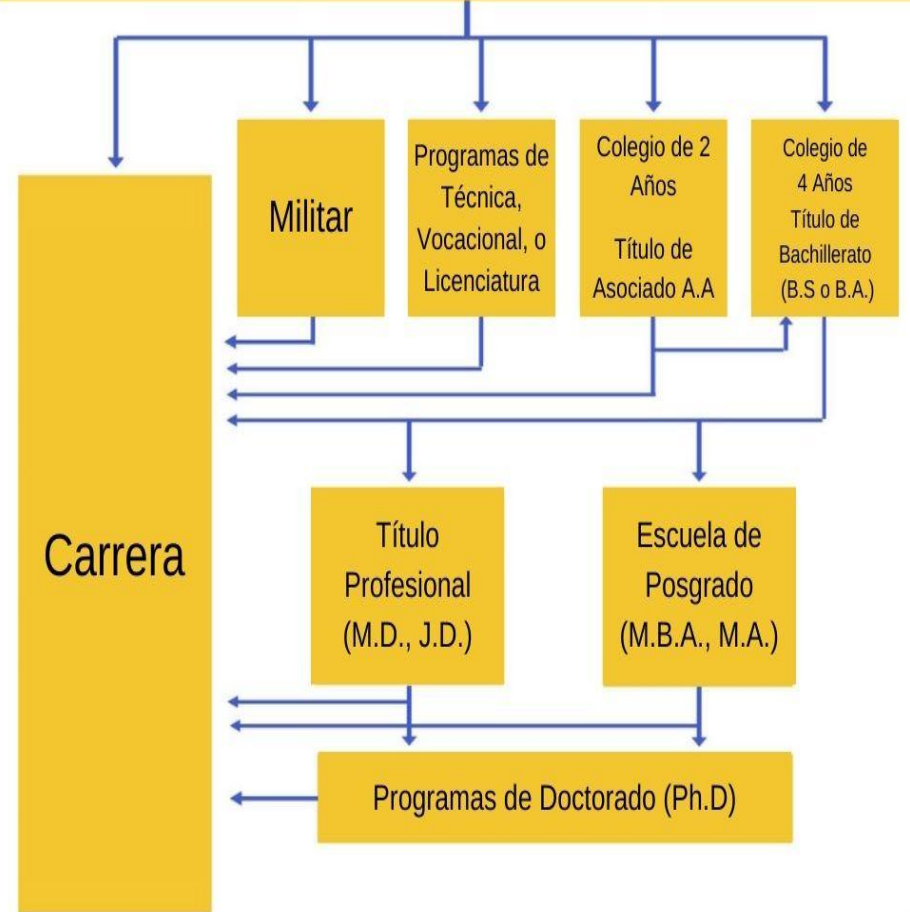
Y eventualmente, todos los estudiantes terminarán en una carrera.

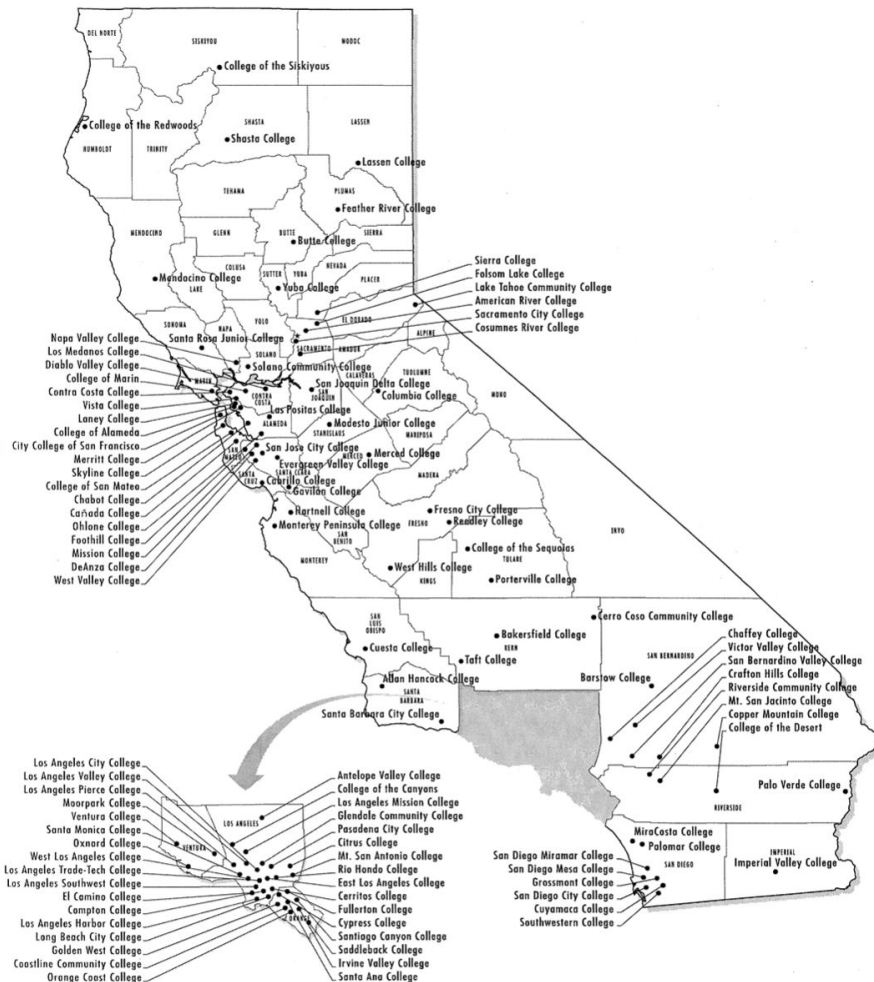
# TIPOS DE COLEGIOS EN CALIFORNIA

- ✘ Community Colleges
  - Example: SBCC
  - 2 year Associate Degree or vocational training/certificate
  - Opportunity to transfer to a 4 year college
  - Requirements to be admitted:
    - 18 years old OR
    - High school diploma
  - SBCC Promise Program
    - 2 years free tuition & required materials for local students

- ✘ Universidades comunitarias
  - Ejemplo: SBCC
  - Título asociado de 2 años o formación profesional/certificado
  - Oportunidad de transferirse a una universidad de 4 años
  - Requisitos para ser admitido:
    - 18 años de edad O
    - Diploma de preparatoria
  - Programa Promesa de SBCC
    - 2 años de matrícula gratis y los materiales necesarios para los estudiantes locales

- ✘ CSU (California State University)
  - Example: Cal Poly San Luis Obispo or CSU Channel Islands
  - 4 year degree (Bachelor's Degree)
  - Requirements to be eligible to apply:
    - Complete coursework in high school (A-G requirements)
    - 2.5 GPA or higher

- ✘ CSU (Universidad Estatal de California)
  - Ejemplo: Cal Poly San Luis Obispo o CSU Channel Islands
  - Titulación de 4 años (Bachelor's Degree)
  - Requisitos para ser elegible
    - Completar los cursos en la escuela secundaria (requisitos A-G)
    - 2.5 GPA o superior

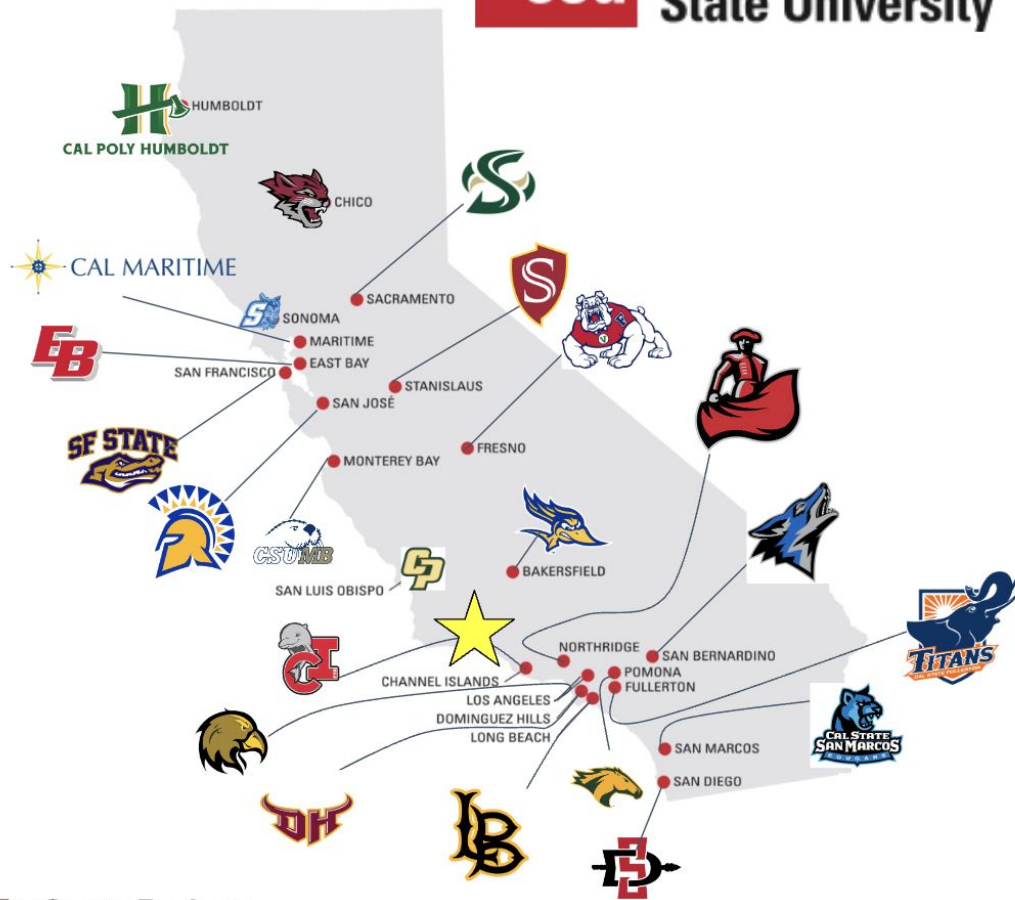

  - Requirements to be eligible to apply:

    - 3.0 GPA or higher

- ✘ UC (Universidad de California)
  - Ejemplo: UCSB
  - Titulación de 4 años (Bachelor's Degree)
  - Requisitos para ser elegible
    - Completar los cursos en la escuela secundaria (requisitos A-G)
    - 3.0 GPA o superior

    - Coursework is usually similar to A-G

- ✘ Colegios privados
  - Ejemplo: Westmont, Cal Lutheran, USC
  - Título de 4 años (Licenciatura)
  - Requisitos para ser elegible:
    - Los cursos suelen ser similares a A-G

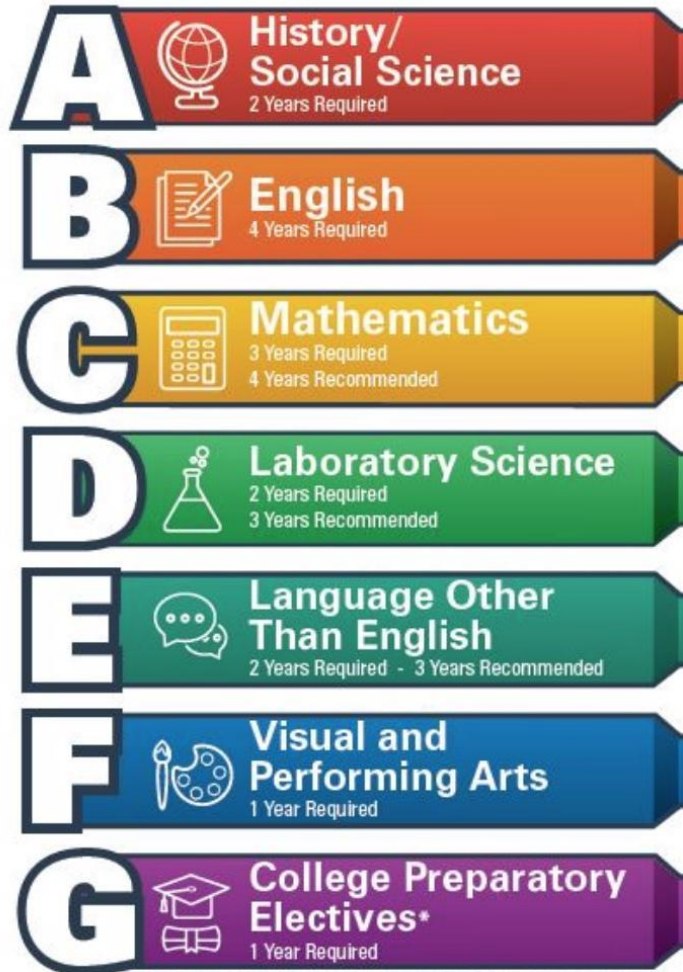

# WHAT ARE THE A-G REQUIREMENTS?

- ✗ A-G stands for the letters associated with the different subject areas.
- ✗ Students complete coursework in the different subject areas to be eligible for college admission.
- ✗ A-G requirements are similar to the SBUSD high school graduation requirements, but not exactly the same.

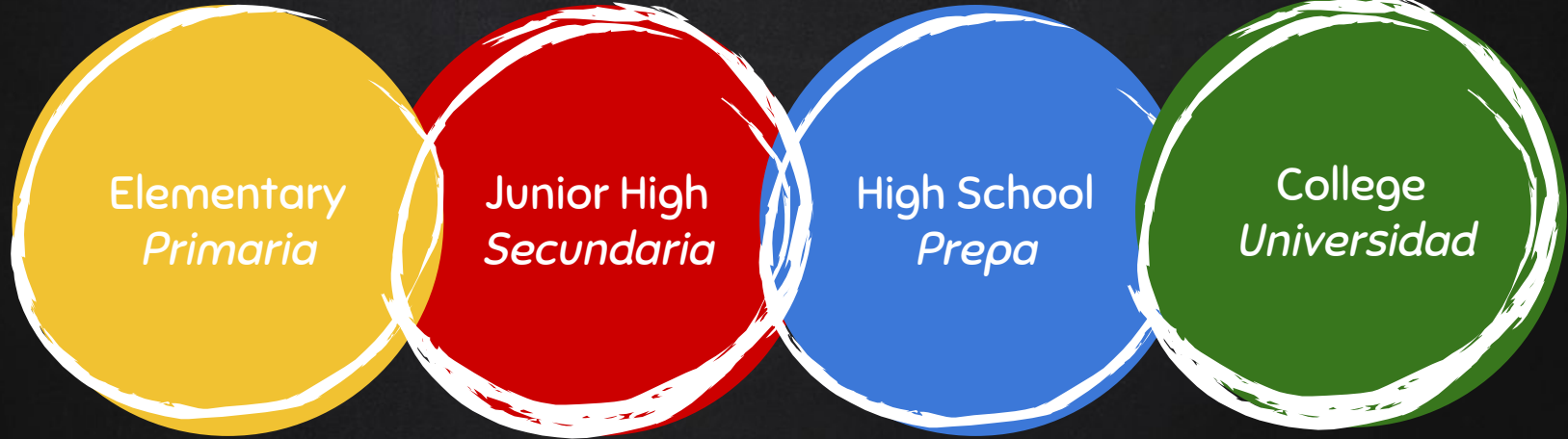
## ¿CUÁLES SON LOS REQUISITOS A-G?

- ✗ A-G son las letras asociadas a las distintas asignaturas.
- ✗ Los estudiantes completan cursos en las diferentes materias para ser elegibles para la admisión a la universidad.
- ✗ Los requisitos de A-G son similares a los requisitos de graduación de la escuela secundaria SBUSD, pero no exactamente los mismos.

# THINGS YOU CAN DO NOW TO HELP YOUR STUDENT



- ✘ Stay connected with your school
  - read communications (ParentSquare)
  - know how to connect with your teacher
  - volunteer/attend events
- ✘ Encourage your students to read 20 minutes a day!
- ✘ Help your student develop good work habits
  - Set up a space to do homework
  - Make sure they turn in their work

# COSAS QUE PUEDE HACER AHORA PARA AYUDAR A SU ESTUDIANTE

- ✘ Mantente conectado con tu escuela
  - leer las comunicaciones (ParentSquare)
  - sepa cómo conectar con su profesor
  - ser voluntario/asistir a eventos
- ✘ Anime a sus alumnos a leer 20 minutos al día
- ✘ Ayude a su estudiante a desarrollar buenos hábitos de trabajo
  - Establezca un espacio para hacer los deberes
  - Asegúrate de que entregan su trabajo

- ✘ Encourage students to ask for help when they need it
- ✘ Have a healthy, balanced life
  - Relax to manage stress
  - Set up responsible electronics use
  - Have a regular sleep schedule
  - Develop/maintain healthy eating habits

- ✘ Animar a los alumnos a pedir ayuda cuando la necesiten
- ✘ Llevar una vida sana y equilibrada
  - Relajarse para controlar el estrés
  - Establecer un uso responsable de los aparatos electrónicos
  - Tener un horario de sueño regular
