Title 1

Amite Elementary is a Title 1 school and receives federal funding. As a Title I school, Amite Elementary has developed a School Wide Plan which includes school goals, activities, and a budget. The School Wide Plan serves as our "road map" for improving student achievement.

School Wide Plan Goals:

- ❖ Increase the percentage of students scoring at or above grade level on district assessments in Math and ELA in grades K-2.
- ❖ Increase student achievement on the LEAP assessment in ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies for grades 3 and 4.
- ❖ Increase the percentage of students scoring at or above grade level on district beginning and end of the year assessments in ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies in grades 3-4.
- ❖ Decrease the percentage of students who are chronically absent.
- ❖ Decrease the percentage of students who receive 1 or more out of school suspensions.
- ❖ Decrease the percentage of referrals in each grade level.
- ❖ Decrease the number of classroom referrals through the implementation of SEL.
